

To the Families of Saint Bernard School,

Re. Grocery Card Sales

We are going to try something new in the way we sell grocery cards. Beginning Sunday, October 4,2015, at the Monthly Children's Masses, we will begin to accept credit cards as payment for grocery cards.

We sell grocery cards at both the church and school. The sales from the school have dropped off sharply. During the 2013-2014 school year, gross sales were \$29,160. During the 2014-2015 school year they dropped by over 60% to \$11,565.

We have been looking for reasons why grocery card sales are so weak. One obvious reason is the drop in enrollment. The enrollment drop, however, was not even close to 60%. Using very conservative assumptions, our families, in total, spend over \$600,000 per year on groceries, yet we sold less than \$12,000 in grocery cards.

One of the most common reasons given for not using grocery cards, is we do not accept credit cards. Besides the convenience of credit cards, they allow families to earn points toward reward programs. In the past, we have resisted accepting credit cards because they would cut into an already narrow profit margin. We are now at the point where we have to try something new. As indicated above, we will begin accepting credit cards at the Children's Masses as payment for grocery cards. If the response is good we will continue to do so and may even look for ways to expand their use.

Grocery cards provide a fundraising opportunity that does not really cost you anything and does not require you to buy anything you really do not need. We ask you to consider using grocery cards when shopping for your family.

As we experiment with accepting credit cards, we will keep you apprised of the results.
