This conference will be of interest to all professionals working within a health and social care context or are involved in the ethical/legal dimensions of health and social care.

Topics include:

- Protecting the vulnerable: the bad and the ugly of social media—What is your ethical responsibility?
- What do the regulators say—the NMC, HCPC and GMC perspective.
- Electronic health and social care records –the ethical considerations for current and future practice.
- The ethics of supporting the social patient.
- Professional development and networking: making social media work for you the ethical way.
- Managing sensitive information in a social world.

The organisers invite abstracts (250 words) on topics that are relevant to clinical ethics and clinical ethics committees, to be submitted for poster-presentation during the conference.

Formats may vary, e.g. from interesting case histories and reports, empirical studies or audits, theory-based analysis etc.

Students and Trainees are especially encouraged to participate. Accepted abstracts will be published in the conference booklet. The authors of the three best abstracts will be invited to deliver a ten minute oral presentation of their poster during the conference.
