- WARM JACKET
- HATS (2) ONE FOR SUN ONE FOR WARMTH
- 1 PAIR RUNNING SHOES
- 1 PAIR HIKING OR STRONG SHOES WITH ANKLE SUPPORT
- 1 WARM SWEATER
- 2 SWEAT SHIRTS
- 3 PAIRS LONG PANTS OR JEANS
- 8-10 T SHIRTS
- 4 PAIRS SHORTS
- 10 PAIRS UNDERWEAR
- 10 PAIRS SOCKS
- 2 PAIRS WARM PYJAMAS
- 2 BATHING SUITS (NO 2 PIECE SUITS PLEASE)
- 1 PILLOW
- 2 PILLOW CASES
- 1 WARM BLANKET
- 1 WARM SLEEPING BAG
(2 IF PARENTS ANTICIPATE THAT ONE MAY HAVE TO BE WASHED DURING CAMP)
- 1 BATH TOWEL
- 2 OLD TOWELS (FOR THE BEACH)
- SWIMMING GOGGLES IF WANTED (INEXPENSIVE ONLY)
- SUNGLASSES (INXPENSIVE ONLY)
- FISHING ROD (IF WANTED)
- FISHING LICENSE (IF OVER 16 YEARS)
- FLASH LIGHT (WITH EXTRA BATTERIES)
- WATER BOTTLE (1 LITRE SCREW TOP, NAMED)
- PEN/PENCIL
- WRITING PAPER/ENVELOPES/STAMPS
- BOOKS, BOARD GAMES IF WANTED

PLEASE PUT THE FOLLOWING IN A CLEARLY MARKED TOILETRY BAG SO THAT IT IS EASIER FOR OUR CAMPERS:

- TOOTHBRUSH/TOOTHPASTE
- SOAP IN A PLASTIC CONTAINER (BIODEGRADABLE IF AVAILABLE)
- HAIRBRUSH/COMB
- INSECT REPELLANT (NO AEROSOLS)
- DEODORANT (NO AERSOLS)
- SUN BLOCK (SPF30 OR MORE)
