There was a king named Pharoah He wasn't like the king in last week's parsha. He was a mean king. He made the Jewish people work very hard. They carried heavy bricks. They were Avadim.

He said all the Jewish baby boys had to be thrown in the Nile River. There was a world under the water. A baby was born. His Imma was Yocheved. His Abba was Amram. His sister was Miriam and his brother was Aharon. His Imma put him in teiva. She put him in the Nile River. Miriam was watching over the baby through the bushes. Princess Batya tried to get the basket out of the Nile River, but her hand was too short. Hashem made a Neis. Hashem made her arm stretch, stretch and then she got the basket. She called the baby Moshe. Because she drew him out of the water.
