Youth Soccer Official

Position Description

Official for youth ages 5 yr - 6th Grades in the Hastings Family YMCA Sports Program. The official is responsible for all aspects of officiating matches. Most of the youth participating will have previous experience playing soccer, but others will be playing their first organized soccer. League games are scheduled for Saturdays between 9am and 12 noon at the soccer fields located behind the Softball Complex north of town. The season begins September 20th, 2014 and continues 6 weeks through October 25th, 2014.

Activities and Responsibilities

1. To arrive at least 30 minutes before the start of games.
2. To help set up fields
3. To assess the conditions of the fields and weather conditions to ensure safety for players
4. To meet with coaches prior to the start of the games to ensure understanding of any rules variations that might be in effect.
5. To ensure that games begin and end at scheduled times.
6. To serve as a positive role model to players, parents, coaches, and fellow officials by enforcing all rules, demonstrating good sportsmanship, and officiating consistently with the Hastings Family YMCA standards.

Qualifications

- Must be of sound mind and good character
- Previous experience in officiating soccer will be a plus
- Must attend the Hastings Family YMCA Officials Training
- Must be committed, dependable and passionate about officiating kid's soccer.
- **Officials are required to officiate at least 5 of 6 weekends**

Benefits

Pay Scale - \$7.25 per game -High school or younger \$8.00/game College or older with the potential for a \$0.25 raise each soccer season (spring + fall)

Officials also have the opportunity to be of service to the community by providing guidance and leadership to our youth. The positive impact that officials can have on the lives of young people is an intangible reward impossible to value.
