

## WHAT WE WANT

### FAIR AND EQUITABLE CONDITIONS

Unemployment also hurts those who have jobs. It drives wages down and working conditions deteriorate.

- Prevent responsible companies from being forced out of the market by others that circumvent laws and regulations.
- Protect employees' rights in the EU constitution with a social protocol.
- Create a strategy for a better working environment in the entire EU. Businesses should not be able to exploit poor working environments to gain a competitive advantage.

### MORE JOBS

There are 26 million unemployed in the EU, of which 6 million young people.

- Ensure that young people get jobs through the realisation of the EU's common youth warranty with a job, education, or practical training within four months.
- Invest in research and innovation for growth.
- Improve the European railway network.

### ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

The cooperation in environmental issues is limping along, both between countries in Europe and between the EU and the rest of the world.

- Invest in environmental technologies which create new jobs.
- Get the EU to take the lead on a new international climate agreement via its own binding targets for halving emissions, increasing use of renewable energy, and establishing energy efficiency goals.
- Prohibit dangerous chemicals which harm people and the environment.
