Competition arena is outdoors, full size (20m X 60m) with sand footing (except USEA tests which are 20x40 (small) arena).


Tests*: Tests are the current USEF, USDF and USEA tests

Decisions/ Disputes:	The judges' decisions are final. If a judge or staff member decides that an animal is not fit to show, that decision will be final as well. Any disputes or problems during the show should be brought to the attention of the show manager at the show office.
Dogs:	Dogs at facility are to be in stabling area only Keep dogs leashed (leash must be solid in nature, 8 feet or shorter **NO retractable leashes** or kenneled at all times. Please provide shade. Please pick up after your pet!
Parking	Competitor and spectator parking by staling in field. No trailer parking by barns or arenas. Keep fire lanes open at all times. Contact the show manager for additional parking requests.
Facility Use:	No spectators in warm-up areas. Horses or dogs should not be tied to any fences or any place that would constitute a hazard. No haul-in horses in boarding resident barns. Stallions shall not be left unattended. Lunge in designated areas only. Barn wash racks for boarding residents only. No stall construction changes allowed. Any damage to stalls will incur a \$150 damage fee and be required to pay for repairs. NO Drones for any reason
Disqualification:	The following may be grounds for disqualification and expulsion without refund: Unsportsmanlike conduct or behavior toward horses, dogs, or humans Unruly, dangerous, or uncontrollable horses Mistreatment of any horse including use of severe bits or training devices Exhibiting a horse that is exhausted, injured or lame Deliberate abuse or damage to WEC property.

RCW 4.24.530 and RCW 4.24.540 provide that an equine activity sponsor (i.e., an individual, group or club, partnership, or corporation, whether or not the sponsor is operating for profit or nonprofit, which sponsors, organizes, or provides the facilities for an equine activity) shall not be liable for an injury to or the death of a participant engaged in an equine activity (i.e., Equine shows, fairs, competitions, performances, or parades that involve any or all breeds of equines and any of the equine disciplines), nor may he or she maintain an action against or recover from an equine activity sponsor for an injury to or the death while engaged in an equine activity. "Participant" means any person, whether amateur or professional, who directly engages in an equine activity (i.e., riding, training, driving, or being a passenger upon an equine, whether mounted or unmounted), whether or not a fee is paid to participate in the equine activity

Release of Liability — Loss and injury. Whidbey Equestrian Center, members of the show committee, staff and their associates will not be responsible for any loss or damage or injury to horses exhibited or for any article of any kind that may be lost or destroyed in any way injured. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be associated with any person whom so ever by any horses owned by, exhibited by, or handled by him and shall indemnify the afore mentioned individuals and organizations against all claims and demands of any kinds or nature that may grow out of and injury associated by any horses owned or exhibited by him or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse. The owner, driver, handler, and rider, and any other agents or representatives acknowledge that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk, and that by participating they expressly assume any risks of injury and loss, and they agree to hold the competition and its officials, directors, employees, or agents. All horses exhibited will be at the owners/lessee's risk.
