The Lexington TeamMates Scholarship

DESCRIPTION

This scholarship has been established to support students who have participated in the local TeamMates of Lexington program with their post-secondary education costs. The TeamMates program believes in the potential of its students to succeed and seeks to do whatever it can through mentoring to support their success. TeamMates is a statewide program with its' central office located in Lincoln; however, all scholarship programs are funded and awarded locally. All qualified applicants will receive a scholarship. The amount of the Lexington TeamMates scholarship will be determined by the number of students submitting a qualified application. A separate renewal scholarship application is established for possible continued support.

QUALIFICATIONS

Consideration for this scholarship will be given to any graduating senior who has actively participated in the local TeamMates of Lexington program through his/her senior year of high school and is pursuing a post-secondary education. The student should have financial need. Active participation may be defined by consistent meetings with mentor(s), participation in TeamMates activities in and outside of school and/or participation in the local Student Advisory Board. TeamMates that have "TeamMates Alumni" status must be able to document consistent meetings with his/her mentor and show continued active participation in TeamMates activities.

INSTRUCTIONS

Each applicant should submit a completed application no later than **April 1** st. The application packet should include:

- 1. Each applicant shall fill out the attached application.
- 2. The applicant must also provide three letters of recommendation. One completed by an instructor whose class the applicant has completed or in which he/she is currently enrolled. One completed by a teacher or sponsor of an activity the student was involved in and the third one completed by the student's mentor, if possible.
- 3. On a separate sheet of paper list, the TeamMates activities the applicant participated in, a description of the applicant's involvement in the activity and the year the activity took place.

The completed scholarship application must be received or turned into the Lexington Community Foundation office by **April 1, 2014**.
