

# Gustavia, St. Barts

The French West Indies island of St. Barts, known for its secluded coves, pristine beaches and picturesque red-roofed houses, was once a destination exclusive to the famous. The island culture reflects its Breton, Norman, French and Swedish influences. Street signs in the capital of Gustavia are in both French and Swedish, as the island at one time was a Swedish colony, and its original fortresses Fort Gustav and Fort Carl are named for the former Swedish monarch and his brother.

Optional activities: a snorkel odyssey to view exotic tropical fish and exquisite coral; a drive to the island's most picturesque view points (a photographer's dream); and an island tour that includes visits to historic sites, an artisan village and a private home.

# Roseau, Dominica

Dominica, one of the youngest islands in the Lesser Antilles and the southernmost of the Windward Islands, is still being formed by geothermal-volcanic activity, evidenced by its large boiling lake. Known for its unspoiled natural beauty, the island has numerous rivers running through lush mountainous rainforests, home to Sisserou Parrots and rare plants and animals long extinct on neighboring islands.

The unspoiled island paradise of Barbados is a stunning tropical jewel known for its pink and white-sand beaches and its curious character—a lingering British colonial atmosphere infused with Carib spirit.

Sailboats speckle the cerulean waters surrounding Gustavia, St. Barts, a posh holiday destination notable for its distinct European influence.

Originally inhabited by Arawak Indians, Barbados was the first landing spot for many westward-sailing Spanish and Portuguese explorers who named it Los Barbados "the bearded ones" for the unusual above-ground roots of the bearded fig trees found there. The capital, Bridgetown, a UNESCO World Heritage site, showcases more than 350 years of English heritage in St. Michael's Cathedral, Queens Park, the Parliament Building and one of the oldest synagogues in the Western hemisphere, established by Brazilian sugar growers in the 1600s.

Optional activities: a nature tour or scenic beach escape; traditional English afternoon tea, or a tour of the world-renowned Mount Gay Rum Distillery, established in 1703.

# Castries, St. Lucia

Approaching the Windward isle of St. Lucia from the sea is a truly magnificent way to view its unmistakable twin volcanic peaks, Gros Piton and Petit Piton, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Many other extinct volcanic domes and craters dot this island of spectacular scenery and unspoiled beaches. For 200 years, control passed back and forth between the British and French until it finally became British in the early 1800s.

Optional activities: board an open-air gondola for a bird's eye view of the rainforest canopy; take an island tour that introduces St. Lucia's culture and beauty; visit a luxury resort or embark a catamaran cruise.

St. John's, Antigua

Antigua has 365 magnificent white-sand beaches, a different one for every day of the year. Near the capital city of St. John's is English Harbour, the meticulously restored 18th-century naval dockyard and home port of Admiral Lord Nelson and his British fleet. Nelson's Lookout Point on Shirley Heights offers spectacular views of the neighboring islands,

Montserrat and Guadeloupe. On Antigua, there are dozens of archaeological sites, the oldest dating back over 4000 years. A collection of pre-Columbian Arawak Indian artifacts can be found in St. John's Museum of Antigua & Barbuda.

Optional activities: historic Antigua tour; helicopter flight over "paradise"; or off-the-beaten-track island exploration.

Road Town, Tortola, British Virgin Islands

The British Virgin Islands, also known as British West Indies, remain a British Crown Colony of 40 mostly uninhabited Leeward Islands. Discovered by Columbus in 1493, they were controlled by Dutch colonists until the British took over in 1666. The largest of these is Tortola, characterized by secluded white-sand beaches, rolling green hills and a yacht-filled harbor.




