## Blackman Middle School Technology Education

The **Tech***Center***21** course offers all students the opportunity to use a computer-based lab in the exploration of careers. The course is divided into content areas which introduce basic technological literacy concepts in the following areas: Road Transportation; Mechanisms; Power and Energy; Engineering Structures; Construction and CAD; Multimedia; Lasers and Fiber Optics; Graphic Design; Video Production; Flight Technology, Mousetrap Vehicles; Desktop Publishing; and Research and Development., Rockets, and Solar Vehicles.
