

Russell N. Van Gelder, MD, PhD earned his MD/PhD from Stanford University. Since 2008, Dr. Van Gelder has been the chair of the Department of Ophthalmology at University of Washington in Seattle. He is director of the UW Medicine Eye Institute and is adjunct professor of Biological Structure and Pathology. He serves as a

trustee of the American Academy of Ophthalmology and serves as chair of the council. His laboratory has been at the forefront of two fields: nonvisual photoreception, and pathogen detection in uveitis. Dr. Van Gelder is widely published and has won numerous awards for his research. Suzanne M.J. Fleiszig, OD, PhD received her Optometry and PhD degrees from the University of Melbourne and completed a postdoctoral fellowship at Harvard Medical School. Currently a Professor of Optometry at the University of California, Berkeley, Dr. Fleiszig has

authored over 90 peer-reviewed publications, most focused on the pathogenesis of contact lens-related corneal infection. She has received multiple awards and lectured extensively.
