- 2. ALL school parties should be registered with the Organisers prior to arriving onsite and there must be a designated GROUP LEADER. Please sign and return the 'School Parties Safety Form' (attached).
- 3. The School must have undertaken a suitable and sufficient RISK ASSESSMENT.
- 4. The GROUP LEADER must have an operational mobile phone. Please ensure that the Organisers, the school and the pupils know the number.
- 5. There must be an appropriate ratio of teachers/adults to pupils as per your LEA Guidelines. Teachers should have a list of the names of each child/student with them. A hi-viz vest is recommended for younger children

AT THE SHOW:

- 6. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 15 YEARS WEARS ONE OF OUR WRISTBANDS – WRITE THE MOBILE NUMBER OF THE TEAM LEADER ON IT
- 7. The LOST PERSONS MEETING POINT is at the EASTERN END OF THE BOULEVARD. Please ensure your visiting party is aware of the location, or to contact a uniformed Security Guard. The Teacher must take a HEADCOUNT regularly and have a floorplan of the show - copies should also be given to the students if they are old enough and everyone should take suitable refreshment regularly throughout the day.
- 8. DO NOT go into restricted areas or on the decks of boats exhibited at height. BEWARE DEEP WATER - Take great care on the Marina and don't let students near the edge. Note where lifebelts are located. It is recommended that large parties of young students do not go onto the pontoons - the Teacher must use individual judgement, especially in inclement weather. However at times all access to the Marina may be stopped at the discretion of the Organisers
- 9. FIRE ASSEMBLY POINTS: Located outside at the West and East ends of the Venue, go to the nearest point. In an emergency an ANNOUNCEMENT will be broadcasted so please follow the directions given.
- 10. FIRST AID: The First Aid Point is in the Centre of the Boulevard, downstairs.
- 11. Teachers must take action against any pupil that acts irresponsibly, does not follow basic safety guidance or is disruptive. Please take them and the group offsite.
