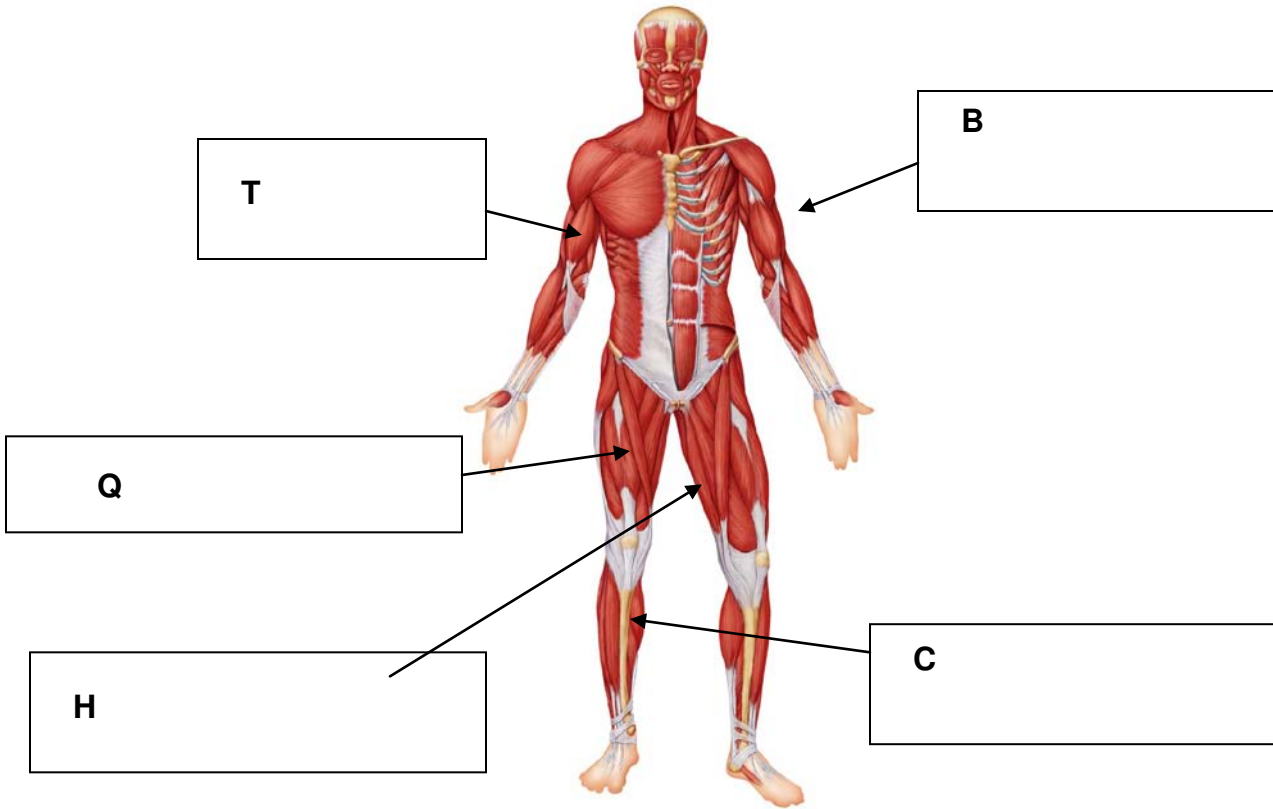

Year 7 - The New Millennium School



Design Situation and brief

The Task

You have been asked by Meopham School to design and make **a prototype card model** of a school. The theme of your design is **NATURE**. Think about a natural product you would like to focus on. For example using recycling materials only or basing it on anything natural. The school may be a model of the school you attend with a modern twist of nature.

Requirements:

1. A model will be made to begin with to learn about netting, developments and tabs in class.
2. **Research** different modern schools - A4 sheet of at least 6 different schools. Use Google to carry out your research.
3. Draw **two** of your favourite ones. **Colour and label**. Use Google sketch if you can
4. Cut out the shape of the school and model.
 - Think about how you will put it together
 - Think about how the school will stand - the foundation.

Limitations:

1. The school must be made from a development drawing and have a front, a roof, sides and a back.
2. The school must have a front doors and back doors for the golf ball to enter and leave.
3. The school must have tabs in order to stick it together.
4. The school must have a detailed front showing windows, doors, ledges etc.
5. The school must be structurally strong.

Extension:

Design a farm area for your school. It may include trees, animals and a fence. You would have to make a plan view drawing of the area.

What preparation do I need?

1. Research on different natural materials
2. Research windows, doors, tables and chairs
3. Draw the school showing your view from the outside and another view from the inside.

Technical Knowledge and Understanding needed:

- How to create and apply tabs onto a net.
- How to use a cutting board and scalpel knife accurately.

Tools and Equipment needed:

- paper
- scissors
- colouring materials e.g. coloured pencils. Paints felt tipped pens.
- card
- scalpel
- cutting mats
- glue

Using Mathematics:

- Applying measurements to drawings.
- Scaling.
- Use of developments.

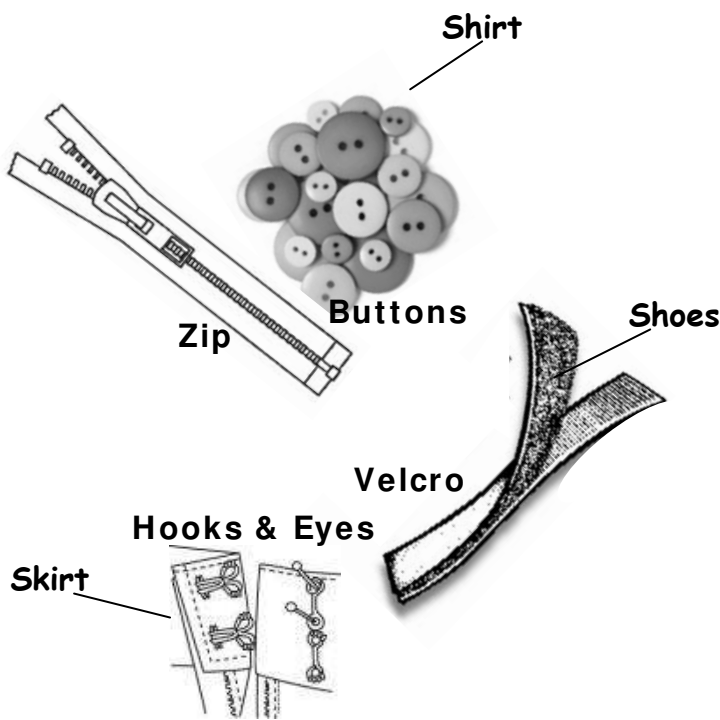
Using software:
