The cost is \$15.00 for one scout & one adult.

CLAW participation (patch, 3 belt loops, program and admission into the Science Center for one scout & one adult.

The Scout & Adult will check in at the registration table, starting at 8:30am, they will get a wristband that allows them to participate at the CLAW event and go into the Science Center. If they have additional family members, siblings/friends or another parent, they will receive a voucher that will allow them to pay a discounted price at the center and get a wristband, which will allow them to go inside & out as they like. Additional children & adults, \$5.00 each for Science Center admission.

No coupons or additional discounts can be used in addition to the discounted price. The only exception are the Science Center memberships.

Belt Loops will be inside & outside the Center.

All Packs are asked to participate by each setting up a Belt Loop Booth. Scouts will visit each booth, we will supply a check off sheet.

Each Scout can pick one Belt Loop to take home and pick two for their Leader to pick up at the October Roundtable.

An Adult must accompany each Scout during the event, NO drop offs!

CLAW participation includes: (patch, 3 belt loops, program and admission into the Science Center for one scout & one adult)

This is the last year for the Sports & Academic Belt Loops, they are discontinued and being replaced with the New Adventure Loops for the Tigers, Wolves & Bears and Adventure Pins for the Webelos. They are still available for purchase until the end of December thru the Scout Shop. Scouts may wear the Belt Loops on their belts along with the new program loops. Depending on the Belt Loops offered at CLAW 2015, some of the old requirements may satisfy some of the NEW Elective requirements.

Admission into the Science Center for additional non scout children & adults - \$5.00 child, \$5.00 adults. No coupons or additional discounts can be used in addition to the discounted price. The only exception are the Science Center memberships.

The Scout & an adult will check in & pay at the registration table starting at 8:30, they will get a wristband that allows them to participate and go into the Science Center. If they have additional family members, siblings/ friends and or another parent/ adult, they will receive a voucher to pay the discounted price at the Science Center and get a wristband, which will allow them to go inside and out as they like.

Scouts will visit each Belt Loop booth and complete the requirements. The Belt Loops are taught by Packs in our Districts, all Packs are asked to participate. The more Belt Loop booths, the better!

The Scouts will get a check off sheet at registration and **be able to take home 1 belt loop**, when they are ready to leave **and order two more for pick up by their Leader at the October Roundtable**, they may complete as many as they like and take the sheet back to their pack for the other belt loops, it is up to the Pack to decide how they would like to get the belt loops for them: parents pay for them, Pack pays, give out a few each month, etc...

Belt Loops will still be available at the Scout Shop until December 2015, either in stock or to be ordered.

The CLAW registration price only applies to your family, so if you have one adult and two scouts participating, you can't give the extra adult wristband to another parent in your Pack.

The Science Center will offer the Astronomy and the Science Belt Loop.

A mobile Planetarium in the Garden Club Building, located in the parking lot, will be included in the CLAW price only for those scouts who sign up for the Astronomy belt loop, it holds 35 people, so you will have to sign up for a show time at the event, the hours for the Mobile Planetarium will only be from 10am until 2pm for CLAW participants.

The Mobile Planetarium is only for Scouts during the events, no parents or siblings.

After the CLAW 10am-2pm event, you may stay and enjoy the Science Center for the rest of the day with your wristband. If you would like to view the Regular Planetarium inside the Science Center after the event, regular costs & viewing times apply.

The mobile Scout Shop will be there for all your basic uniform needs!

Rita's Ice will be there. Subway is located inside the Science Center.

BELT LOOP BOOTHS

Packs from all Districts are asked to set up a Belt Loop booth. Bring your own canopies for outside, the Center will provide tables & chairs, if you need them. **We cannot have a successful event without Pack participation! Huge area outside the Science Center, plenty of room to spread out.**

Pick a Belt Loop for your pack, get all your leaders & parents involved...make a schedule for the event, so you're not the only one at the booth, ask everyone to volunteer an hour, so you can enjoy the other time with your scout at the event. Most Belt Loops only have 3 requirements!

We will have Pack belt loop booths in the museum along with the ones outside. We may have up to 5 booths inside the Center. I think the ones that need electricity would benefit from being inside.

All booths inside - children of adults teaching the belt loop must supervise their kids at all times, remember this is a regular Saturday for the Science Center. Adult leaders teaching inside the Center will need to get special wristbands, see Joanne Moniger for those the day of the event. She will need a list of your Belt Loop booth experts.

There is an exhibit inside the Science Center this year: Their summer exhibit, **Eww! What's Eating You?** is destined to get under your skin- in a good way! It's a must-see exhibit that will dig into the history of human/parasite interaction from ancient Greece, Rome, and Egypt to more modern tales of these often-sinister critters that live to hitch a ride on human hosts.

Belt Loops

There are 28 sports activity areas: 18 below could be done at CLAW

Badminton, Baseball, Basketball, Bicycling, **Fishing**, Flag Football, Fitness, Gymnastics, **Marbles**, Roller Skating, Soccer, Softball, Table Tennis, Ultimate, Volleyball, Hiking, Kickball, & Skateboarding.

And, 25 academics activity areas:

Art, **Astronomy**, **Chess**, Citizenship, Collecting, **Communicating**, Computers, Geography, **Geology**, **Heritages**, Language & Culture, **Map & Compass**, Mathematics, Music, **Science**, Weather, Wildlife Conservation. Disabilities Awareness, Family Travel, Good Manners, Nutrition, Pet Care, **Photography**, Reading and Writing, & Video Games
