

2010 Literary Awards Call for Submissions

PEN Center USA's Annual Literary Awards, established in 1982, are a unique, regional competition that recognizes literary excellence in ten categories: fiction, creative nonfiction, research nonfiction, poetry, children's literature, translation, journalism, drama, teleplay, and screenplay. PEN USA is accepting submissions of work produced or published in 2009 by writers living west of the Mississippi River. Entries in the ten categories are reviewed and judged by panels of distinguished writers, critics and editors. Winners are announced in late summer. Each receives a \$1,000 cash prize, a year of PEN membership, and will be PEN's guest at the Annual Literary Awards Festival in Los Angeles.

The Festival is held at the Beverly Hills Hotel and features a dinner, the awards ceremony, and a silent auction or raffle. This gala draws over 500 prominent writers, editors, publishers, actors, and directors.

GUIDELINES & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Authors and translators whose primary residence is in the United States, **west of the Mississippi River, including all of Minnesota and Louisiana**. For works authored by two or more writers, the majority of the writers must reside west of the Mississippi River, including all of Minnesota and Louisiana. Works may be submitted by authors, their publishers, agents, or publicists.

ELIGIBLE SUBMISSIONS

Books of outstanding literary merit originally published in 2009 in the following categories:	Non-book categories include works originally published or produced in 2009:

Book category submissions must be received by Dec. 31, 2009	Non-book category submissions must be received by Jan. 31, 2010

WHAT TO SUBMIT

- Four (4) copies of the entry
- Completed entry form (Must include author's state of residence)
- \$35 entry fee for each submission
- Self-addressed stamped postcard for confirmation of receipt (Optional)

ATTENTION

- Anthologies, publish-on-demand, and self-published books are not eligible.
- Entries will not be returned.
- We will not select a category on your behalf. You must select only one.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

Entries will be read and evaluated by a distinguished panel of judges. The judges will select one winner and up to four finalists for each category. Winners will be announced in summer of 2010.
