Art Box: If your child's art box is not in good condition from last year, please purchase another box.

The box must have a lid and must be large enough to fit all of their art supplies. However, the box cannot be larger than 14 " X 10 " and no taller than $31 / 4$ " in order to fit in their cubby. Usually a box that is at least $11 " \mathrm{X} 7$ " is big enough, but make sure it is not taller than $31 / 4$ ".

The best place to look for a box this size is in the food storage section or general storage section of stores like Wal-Mart, Meijer, and Dollar General.

Clorox disinfecting wipes: If your child needs to bring disinfecting wipes, please buy the Clorox brand due to state health board regulations.

Bookbags: Please remember that students will not be permitted to use wheeled bookbags.

Empty Shoe Box: Students in grades 1-4 will need to bring an empty shoe box in April, 2015 to bring art supplies home. A reminder note will be sent in April.

Please mark personal items for your child with a permanent marker. Items like Kleenex, paper towels, baggies, and Clorox wipes do not have to be marked.

A homework folder will be purchased through the school for students in grades 1-3 and added onto your child's bookbill. An assignment notebook will be purchased through the school for students in grades 1-6 and added onto your child's bookbill.

Money: Please remember that lunch money must be in an enclosed envelope with the student's name, account number, and payment amount on it.

If you are not on a family account, one check can still be written for all your children's lunches. On the envelope write each student's name, account \#, and payment amount. DO NOT combine lunch money with bookbill payments. Separate checks need to be written.
