LUCY MILNE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

- The scholarship is to be awarded to personnel who are currently pursuing or will be pursuing an
 education in a related field at an accredited Post-Secondary institution or who wish to apply the
 funding to a course and/or course materials that are related to furthering the mission, vision and or
 values of Between Friends.
- The award is intended to assist Between Friends in recruitment and retention of personnel whose function is to work directly with the participant members of the organization.
- To be eligible, staff and volunteers must meet at least one of the following for the calendar year of 2013:

The Selection Committee can assign additional 1 or 2 scholarship recipients to any category; to a maximum of two (2) recipients.



- Staff and volunteers must be:
 - o currently enrolled in or pursuing full-time or part-time enrollment in a related field or another field deemed acceptable by the Between Friends Selection Committee; and/or
 - o pursuing a course related to the field in which Between Friends operates; should an applicant not be enrolled in a related field in an accredited Post-Secondary institution, the applicant must state the intended course at the time of application.
- All scholarships awarded will be based on involvement with Between Friends, the impact the
 organization has had on the applicant and/or the impact the applicant has had on the organization or
 the community, and most importantly, the applicant's plans for future involvement with the organization.
 The scholarship will also be based on how the education being obtained may directly impact Between
 Friends.
- Scholarships of a maximum of \$1,000.00 each will be awarded to a maximum of ten (10) applicants per year.
- Scholarship deadlines for 2013 will be: November 15, 2013 at 4:00 p.m. MST.
- Recipients will be notified by phone. Only those who have been awarded a scholarship will be notified.
- The scholarship will be awarded to the successful applicant(s) upon the following:
 - o Completion of the course/semester with receipts and proof of successful completion; course/semester must be completed by December 15, 2014.
 - Enrollment and completion of the next Program Session; follow through on the applicant's plans for future involvement with the organization.
- Failure to complete either of the two above mentioned requirements will result in forfeit of the scholarship.
- Applicants are limited to receiving one (1) scholarship through Between Friends per calendar year. Previous scholarship recipients must wait for one full calendar year before applying again.

DOCUMENTATION TO ACCOMPANY THIS APPLICATION

Applicants are required to submit:

- The attached Application Form
- The submitted essay MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:
 - The number of hours either worked or volunteered with Between Friends and in what capacity/role, indicating which program(s).
 - How the course/area of study will directly impact Between Friends.
 - How Between Friends has impacted the applicant and/or how the applicant has impacted Between Friends, persons with disabilities and the wider community.
 - The applicants plan for future involvement with Between Friends.

This may NOT exceed a total of TWO typewritten, one and half-spaced pages.

Proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institute or applicable course.

The Human Resources Lead will provide the Selection Committee with a copy of the admission essay.
