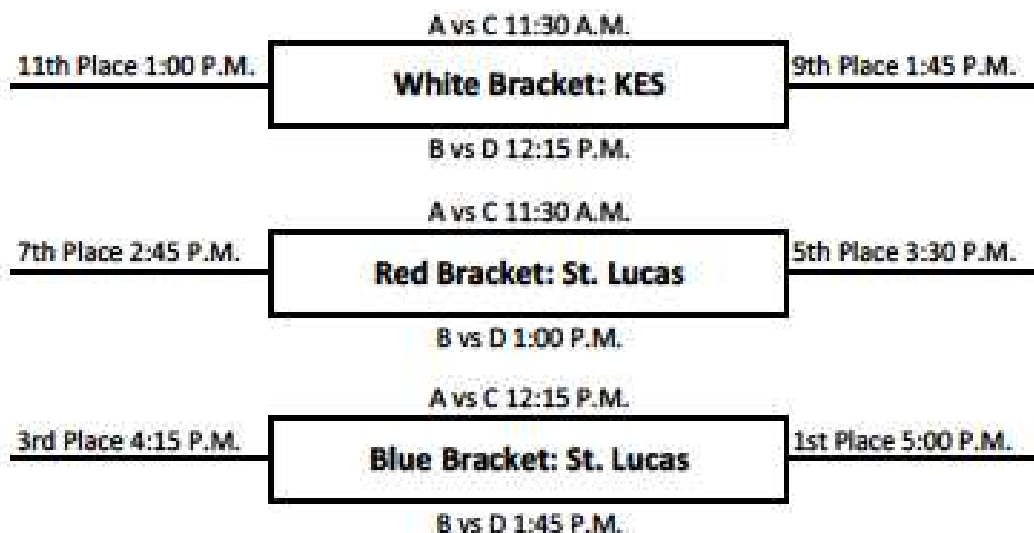

Morning Star Ski/Snowboard Group

Have you ever wanted to learn how to ski or snowboard but never had the chance? Last year a group of kids from

Morning Star went to Sunburst Ski Hill in Kewaskum for their Learn to ski/board program after school. This was a great opportunity to learn a lifelong sport with friends so we will be doing it again this year.

A carpool leaves from school at 3:30 PM to arrive at the hill by 4:00. The program offers rentals, lesson and lift ticket for 4 sessions. The kids are taken through 7 learning zones throughout the program. The format is lessons for one hour and then open ski/board for the 1.5 hours each week. At 6:30 everyone is counted and accounted for and the carpool returns to Morning Star at 7:00 for parents to pick up. Anyone who was in the program last year will start where they left off last year. All grades are invited. They suggest age 8 for snowboard and age 6 for skiing. We could use the help of some chaperones to assist in driving and keeping track of the kids at the hill. We would plan on having the parents pack food for dinner that the kids could bring.

We are planning on doing the program on Mondays starting in December. The dates will be spread across December and January. Once the program completes the child will receive a pass that allows them to return anytime for \$12 for lift and rental and they can bring a friend for \$17 for the same deal. We are starting earlier so the kids have the reduced price pass sooner.

The program cost is different for snowboard or skiing.

Junior Charger Boy's Youth Basketball Program

The Junior Charger Youth Basketball Club is looking forward to beginning its 13th season of offering competitive basketball this winter. Our program offers individuals in the KML Federation the opportunity to participate on a club basketball team with other players from within the Federation who have a similar interest and ability in basketball. The Junior Charger program supports one team at each grade level 5-8, unless we have enough talent to start two teams at a certain age level.

Practices for the 2013 season will begin sometime after the tryouts and the season concludes in early April with an awards banquet. Each grade level team carries a squad of twelve players. Teams will practice at local Federation gyms and participate in various tournaments at a variety of different locations. The Junior Charger program is not intended to replace your participation with your Federation grade school. It is intended to offer kids who have the passion, drive, and ability the opportunity to play basketball at a higher level with other kids from within the KML Federation under the guidance of WELS member coaches.

Registration fees are \$140 for the first child and \$110 for any additional players from the same family. These fees help defray the cost of uniforms, gym fees, practice jersey and tournament entry fees. Additionally, families are required to donate 3hrs of time at the Junior Charger tournament held at KML.

Tryouts for the 2013 Junior Charger teams will be held as follows:

Players are encouraged to attend both tryouts. We ask all players to fill out a registration form and send it to Coach Rusch at the address provided or Coach Jahns at KML by Oct. 24th. All basketball players within the KML Federation are encouraged to tryout, **we especially need players at the 8th grade level**, but we ask players and parents to consider the following expectations before committing to our program:

- eighth grade players will need to register for their freshman year at KML in December.
- fifth through seventh grade players should plan on attending KML
- teams will begin practices sometime after the tryouts; players are expected to attend practices unless excused by the coach (grade school practices, games, and school functions take priority over Junior Charger events).
- games consist of 5-6 selected weekend tournaments at various locations.
- parent volunteer time (about 3hrs) is required to help run our Junior Charger tournament.
- academic responsibility and staying up to date on homework are a top priority.
- families need to consider how this will impact your family time.
- players should participate in our summer league which is one night a week in June and July.

All teams will be posted on our website www.eteamz.com/juniorchargers by Nov. 8th. Once teams are selected we will hold a parent meeting to collect the \$135 player fee and size players for their uniforms.

Our main purpose and goal has always been and will continue to be the development of our younger players. Our coaching staff strives hard to create a positive learning experience and provides quality instruction at each practice. Players will be challenged to develop their individual skills as players while working together for the common good of their team. Along the way, players develop some great new friendships with future classmates and have a great time playing the game of basketball.

Once again, our staff encourages all of you to consider trying out and joining our program. If the player fee hinders a player from trying out for the team, please contact Coach Jahns so that we can make other arrangements to allow your son to participate in the program.
