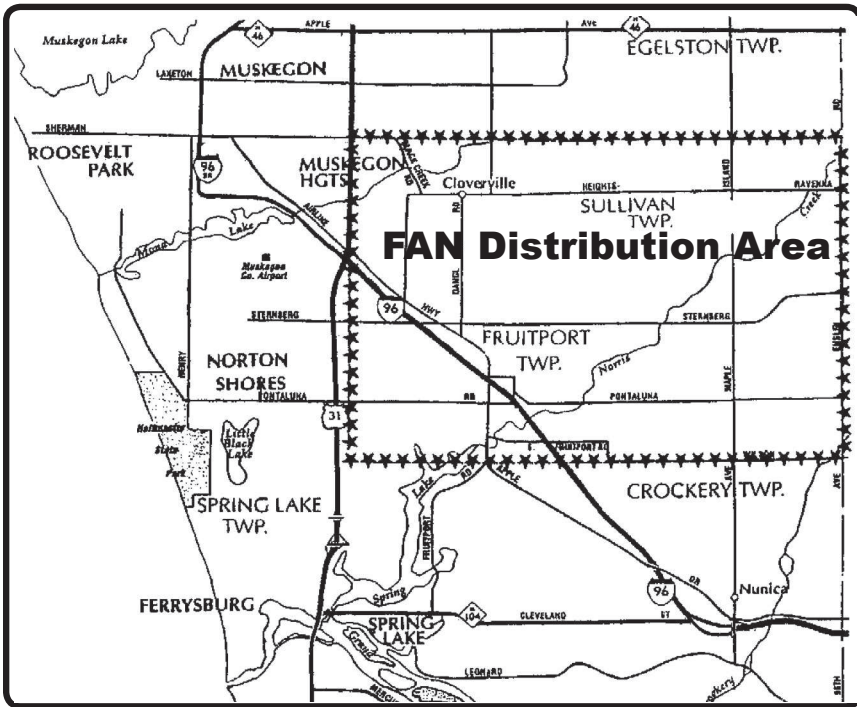

**On Friday, August 9, 2013, at 7:00 p.m. in Coopersville High School's Centerstage Theater,** James Popenhagen and his band the HiLo's will headline a "Hats Off To Del Shannon" concert of nearly 2 hours of nonstop Rock n' Roll favorites. The family friendly entertainment event celebrates the 20th Anniversary of the Coopersville Area Community Foundation. The Foundation is the major sponsor of the concert whose proceeds will benefit the Coopersville Area Historical Society Museum's fund for a future expansion.

Concert tickets, which can be purchased at the door, are \$10 for adults and \$8.00 for students. Advance tickets will be available in Coopersville at the Comerica Main Street branch, City Hall on Danforth St., The Historical Museum at 363 Main St. or Budzynski Photography at 321 Main St. Tickets may also be ordered on line at [GALLERY293.COM](http://GALLERY293.COM), and received via e-mail.

James Popenhagen is a singer/songwriter who has been performing since the age of eight. Over the years, he has worked with many performers and has contributed to a dozen albums. Since 2011, he released at least three solo albums. He and the HiLo's have toured with their 50's and 60's concert to sold out audiences. James was featured in a hit performance during an August, 2011 concert presented by the Coopersville Historical Society in honor of the 50th anniversary of "Runaway," Del Shannon's megahit recording. Del Shannon was raised as Charles Westover in Coopersville where he graduated from high school in 1953.
