On the contrary: "If you enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head." Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

May we all be inspired to grow in our love for God and for each other as we draw near to the great feast of Mary, the Holy Mother of God.
