- ❖ Packs must have one adult for every one to four boys attending camp (*Tiger Cubs must have one adult per Tiger Cub and they do not count towards the 1 to 4 ratio nor as Pack Adult Leaders*).
- ❖ Boys and adults **need** to bring a sack lunch on Saturday. They should also dress appropriately (NO open toe shoes) for the weather forecast, like sunscreen and head gear.
- ❖ Boys attending the Webelos overnighter should bring an item to share at the cracker barrel campfire (cookies, crackers, etc).
- ❖ Mark jackets, hats, dinner containers etc. with boy's name and pack number.
- ❖ Any boy that is to be released from Day Camp prior to the end of the day <u>MUST</u> check out and fill out release form before leaving.
