**ACTS** is an acronym for **A**doration, **C**ommunity, **T**heology and **S**ervice. It is these four themes that are the focus of activities during the weekend.

ACTS is inspired by the ACTS of the Apostles 2:42-47

*"The devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to prayer. Awe came upon everyone and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. All who believed were together and had all things in common: they would sell their property and possessions and divide them among all according to each one's need. Every day they devoted themselves to meeting together in the temple area and to breaking bread in their homes. They ate their meals in exultation and sincerity of heart, praising God and enjoying favor with all the people. And every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved."*
