What is Adopt-A-Park?

Adopt-A-Park is a cooperative partnership between the public and private sectors and the City of Pasadena. It is a program that allows both individuals or groups to actively be involved in the community through the adoption of a section of park or even a complete city park...there are over 40 to choose from.

Participants agree to perform cleanups and monitoring for one year. This will greatly enhance the appearance and quality of our park areas, contributing to a community reputation for recreational excellence throughout our region.

What do you need to do?

Here's all you need to do:

- Submit an application to adopt
- Select the particular section of park or complete park you wish to adopt
- Sign an agreement to perform the monitoring and cleanup up to four times a year for one year
- Agree to comply with safety procedures
- Submit a report after each monitoring or cleanup



What does it cost?

All it costs is just a few volunteer hours. The City's Adopt-A-Park Program fully supplies you with the necessary trash bags, gloves, safety vests and forms for reporting your results at no cost to you or your participating organization.

How does the program work?

Volunteers will remove any trash and debris that can reasonably be handled by one or two people. Larger debris will be removed by City crews upon notification by the volunteer.

Trash and debris should be bagged and set out for pickup by City sanitation staff..


Volunteers also provide valuable reporting on the condition of walking trails, playground equipment and any situations involving possible problems in bayous, creeks or lakes that are part of the park.
