The Mind of the Predator/Psychopath

Part 1: Exploring the Dark Side

This seminar is the first of a two-part series on the mind of the predator/psychopath. Part 1 will discuss personality traits, symptoms of predatory behavior, diagnostic criteria, assessment of the risk for violence and legal and clinical issues involving treatment of individuals displaying predatory behaviors. Discussion will also include examination of the role of gender in predatory behavior. Frank discussion will include videos of actual case studies. The Mind of the Predator/Psychopath *Part 2: Forensic Treatment Strategies* will be held on Friday, March 30, 2012, and focus on clinical treatment of this complicated population.

Frederick J. Nastri, M.A., L.P.C., L.C.P.C., is a clinical counselor with over 37 years of experience in criminal justice, forensics and mental health. He is retired from the Maryland Department of Public Safety Corrections Services after 27 years of work in treatment and assessment of psychopathic and mental health disorders. Previously, he spent 10 years as a police officer and detective with the Hagerstown City Police Department. Mr. Nastri is an adjunct instructor for Hagerstown Community College and Mountain State University and is a member of the American Association of Psychotherapists.

Discussion will include:

- Personality traits of a predator;
- Symptoms of predatory behavior;
- The psychology of inferiority;
- Differentiating between the predator and the psychopath;
- The role of gender and predatory behavior;
- Differing agencies who identify and refer for treatment;
- Social and situational correlates;
- Unconscious motivations;
- Technology and personality.

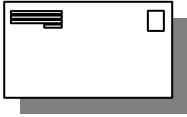

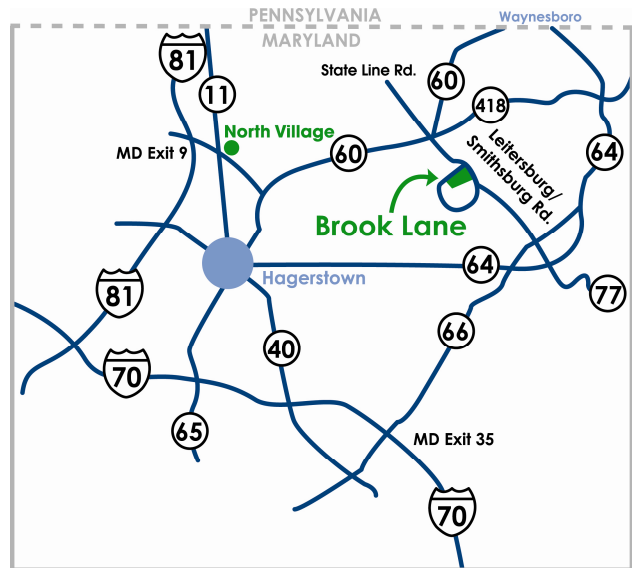

Brook Lane's Community Room is located in the lower level of the Hospital Building. When you enter the campus follow the directional signs.

From Interstate 70

- Take MD exit 35 (Smithsburg/Boonsboro Rt. 66)
- From the West, turn left off the exit
- From the East, turn right off the exit
- Proceed North on Rt. 66 (approx. 6 miles)
- Drive straight through first traffic light at intersection with Rt. 64
- Proceed to second traffic light at Main Street, Smithsburg, turn left
- Proceed 2.6 miles
- Brook Lane will be on the left



From Interstate 81

- Take MD exit 9 Maugans Ave (which will become Long Meadow Road)
- From the North (Pennsylvania), turn left off the exit
- From the South (West Virginia, I-70), turn right off the exit
- Proceed 3.1 miles to Rt. 60 traffic signal, turn left onto Rt. 60 North
- Proceed 3.3 miles, turn right on Leithers Mill Rd (which will become Leithersburg/Smithsburg Rd)
- Proceed 1.3 miles
- Brook Lane will be on the right

From Emmitsburg

- From the square, proceed West on MD Rt. 140 (which becomes Pennsylvania Rt. 16)
- Proceed 16.2 miles, turn left at the light onto Midvale Road (which becomes MD Rt. 418)
- Proceed 6 miles, turn left onto MD Rt. 60 South
- Proceed 0.2 miles, turn left onto Leithers Mill Road
- Proceed 1.3 miles
- Brook Lane will be on the right

From Gettysburg

- Proceed West on PA 16 to the intersection, turn right onto PA Rt. 16 West
- Proceed 9.8 miles, turn left at the light onto Midvale Road (which becomes MD Rt. 418)
- Proceed 6 miles, turn left onto MD Rt. 60 South
- Proceed 0.2 miles, turn left onto Leithers Mill Road
- Proceed 1.3 miles
- Brook Lane will be on the right

From Waynesboro

- Take Potomac Street (Rt. 316) South, which will become MD Rt. 60
- Proceed 5 miles, turn left onto Leithers Mill Road
- Proceed 1.3 miles
- Brook Lane will be on the right
