

About the Program

Bullying has become a significant concern as students with physical or cognitive advantages intimidate and exploit their more vulnerable classmates, often with sophistication and discreetness that makes it difficult for adults to observe and intervene. This seminar will examine bullying through the lens of cognitive neuroscience providing a new perspective and an alternative set of tools to manage these perplexing behaviors.

Heather Higgins, LCSW-C, is the director of training and development for The Upside Down Organization where she provides brain based workshops and presentations to parents, teachers, social workers and others serving children. She is also the director of the Family Help Center, an outpatient mental health clinic in Baltimore, MD. 
