Here's what you need to do:

- 2. Read the 2008 or newer Radio Merit Badge pamphlet from pages 1 to 67. You do not have to build the crystal radio, but it is fun!
- 3. Once we receive your registration, we will email a workbook to you, with further instructions.
- 4. Bring the following to the class:
 - a. A **fully completed** Merit Badge Application (Blue Card) for the Radio Merit Badge signed by one of your unit leaders.
 - b. Your workbook, completed as best you can.
 - c. The Radio Merit Badge Worksheet with evidence of any requirements you may have completed in advance.
 - d. A pen and pencil, and a notebook or clipboard to write on.
 - e. Proper uniform (if a Scout), good behavior and interest!
 - f. A snack/sandwich if you want one.
- 5. Report to the Palatine EOC by 1:15pm on Sunday afternoon. If your parents are <u>not</u> staying, make sure that you are picked up by 4:30pm.
