YMCA Camping Services 3-Tier Rate Structure

Realizing that families have different abilities to pay, YMCA Camp Silver Creek has implemented a three-tier rate structure for our camping programs. You may choose the rate structure that is most suitable for your family. This is a voluntary program and **in no way influences the experience children receive at camp.** We feel this program offers the opportunity for families to take an active role in supporting the true cost of their child's camp experience. (Prices shown are examples)

Tier I - \$235 - Member price

Members pay an annual or ongoing monthly fee which offsets their program costs.

Tier II - \$335 - Subsidized price (No financial aid paperwork required)

This is our standard subsidized fee. This rate more accurately accounts for the basic costs of attending camp. If you cannot afford the cost of Tier II, we offer financial assistance to those that qualify.

Tier III - \$410 - Regular price

This price more accurately accounts for the true costs of attending camp.

The YMCA provided over \$30k in scholarships last year. We make every effort to make sure that a child has an opportunity to experience camp no matter what the families ability to pay is.
