If you are a non-member, you have the choice of choosing between the higher rate (Tier III) which more accurately reflects the actual cost of camp for a week or the subsidized rate (Tier II) which requires no additional paperwork. If you are unable to afford the subsidized rate (Tier II), then please call the registration desk at 503-399-2759 to have a financial aid application mailed to you or go to our website www.salemymcacamps.com and download a financial aid application.

We feel this program offers the opportunity for families to take an active role in supporting the true cost of their child's camp experience. (Prices shown are examples) Tier I - \$235 - Member price Members pay an annual or ongoing monthly fee which offsets their program costs. Tier II - \$335 - Subsidized price (No financial aid paperwork required) This is our standard subsidized fee. This rate more accurately accounts for the basic costs of attending camp. If you cannot afford the cost of Tier II, we offer financial assistance to those that qualify. Tier III - \$410 - Regular price | |
