**YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL VISIT 2013
Bryn-y-Moel Centre, Llanbedr, Gwynedd
Monday 24th – Friday 28th June 2013**



We are pleased to announce that the Year 6 Residential Experience opportunity has been provisionally booked at the Bryn-y-Moel Centre, Llanbedr, Gwynedd for the above dates in June.

We have previously used this centre for residential visits and it provides an excellent opportunity for the children to experience outdoor pursuits under the supervision of well qualified and experienced instructors. Activities such as archery, team challenges, kayaking, gorge walking and an overnight expedition are available and provide individual and group challenges. There are also a range of facilities which can be used including pool table, table tennis and a sports court. The residential visit has proven to be an exciting, challenging and memorable experience for our Y6 over the past years and it is our hope that all our Y6 students will be able to benefit from this exciting opportunity, which develops outdoor learning and important personal and social skill development at this age. The visit will be led by Miss McIlwain accompanied by Mrs Patterson and supported Mrs Hawgood and Mrs Garrard. Further staffing to be confirmed.

The cost for the week will be **£331 per student**; this includes all transport, accommodation, food, a full programme of outdoor activities with necessary equipment and resources provided and entrance to Harlech Castle.

In order to secure the booking we would ask that **parents complete the reply slip below indicating your child's commitment to participating in the Y6 Residential together with a deposit of £50 per student by December 14th.**

The balance of £281 can be made in two instalments of £140.50. The first instalment of £140.50 is payable by February 30th and the second instalment of £140.50 is payable by April 30th. Parents paying the total balance should make the payment by April 30th at the latest.

Payments made online through our secure online ParentPay service is the school's preferred method of payment. A record of payments is kept via Parent Pay. However if you would prefer to pay by

cheque/cash, please send the money in a named, sealed envelope to the Primary Office.

We will be holding an **information evening for parents on March 11th at 7pm** when all the arrangements for the visit will be covered in detail.

Parents support in enabling the school to provide a week's residential experience is much appreciated.
