Janesville International Education Program Requirements for Admission School Year 2015-2016

For admission to the 2015-2016 school year, submit all application forms by March 1, 2015. Instructions on how to complete the application and a list of all needed forms are included with the application to assist you in completing all necessary information. All documents need to be typed and submitted in English on the School District of Janesville forms provided. Any incomplete information may lead to a denial or a delay in student acceptance or admission to the program. (For consideration of school year transfer requests, each request will be reviewed on a case by case basis and require optional/additional paperwork and may be subject to additional fees) The School District of Janesville (SDJ) is an USCIS approved school in the United States.

Student Requirements:

- Student MUST be under 19 years of age on August 31, 2015.
- Student MUST NOT have already graduated from a high school in home country.
- School Certified Transcripts from grades 9 and 10 (Junior status) or grades 9, 10 and 11 (Senior status) are required and must contain a school seal and administrator signature.
- Official TOEFL score report is required for admission. Grade 11 minimum score is 60-65 and grade 12 minimum score is 80-85. Included in the application on <u>Application Form</u> page 4 is more information on taking the test if you have not already done so. Follow those directions for where and how to take your test. Please use 7586 in the school code section for the release of your test scores, they will be sent directly to us.
- Completion of additional forms and fee collection after VISA has been received is required prior to admission (more on this below).

Grade Level Identification:

- Junior status is granted when student has successfully completed US grades 9 and 10.
- Senior status is granted when student has successfully completed US grades 9, 10 and 11.

Preparations for F-1 Visa:

- Once you have submitted your application forms, the School District of Janesville will review and if accepted, you will receive a SEVIS I-20 Form with your acceptance letter.
- After you have submitted your application with the School District of Janesville, you will need to apply for your F-1 Visa. The SEVIS I-901 fee is required for all F-1 students PRIOR TO APPLICATION for F-1 visitors. Paying the SEVIS I-901 fee is very important. Without this fee, you will not be eligible to apply for a visa. To learn more, click on this link: <u>http://www.ice.gov/sevis/i901/faq.htm</u>
- You can fill out the I-901 form on line at: <u>www.fmjfee.com</u> (Make sure your Form I-20 information matches that on your SEVIS I-901 form).

- F-1 Visa appointments are usually scheduled about 10-20 days from the point of contact. You MUST HAVE your SEVIS I-20 Form and your acceptance letter when you go to your Visa appointment.

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Preparations for Final Admissions to the School District of Janesville:

- Once we are notified that you have received your F-1 Visa, we will send you additional forms via email that will be needed to meet final admission requirements.
- Full payment of 1st semester tuition is required by Electronic Wire Transfer prior to your arrival in the USA (an invoice for payment with instructions will come with the additional forms). There is a form in the application packet that will needed signed as the tuition agreement
- Placement tests will be sent for completion to determine which subject level will be best for student success.
- You must provide proof of health insurance that covers you in the United States through the duration of your stay here and should be part of your final paperwork. There are many vendors that can provide this insurance, see <u>https://www.compassstudenthealthinsurance.com/compare_international_insurance_plans</u>.
 <u>php</u> or <u>http://www.internationalstudentinsurance.com/f1student/</u> for example. Minimum requirements are as follows:
 - Medical benefits of at least \$50,000 per accident or illness
 - Repatriation of remains in the amount of \$7,500
 - Expenses associated with the medical evacuation of the exchange visitor to his or her home country in the amount of \$10,000
 - A deductible not to exceed \$500 per accident or illness.

Orientations:

Home Country – students will participate in at least one orientation prior to departing from home country

United States – additional orientations will take place upon arrival at SDJ to help prepare students for the American culture, provide English training with an American teacher and an overview of the American education system.

Degree Completion and Transition to Higher Education:

- Students are eligible to graduate from the School District of Janesville High Schools upon successful completion of required courses.
- An assigned counselor will assist students with college applications, scholarships and financial aid forms.
- All international students will take ACT prep courses to prepare for the ACT college entrance test. As a Junior or Senior, students will take the ACT college entrance test.
- Students will take the TOEFL again near graduation for acceptance into American Universities examples of required minimums are included in the application materials.

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Janesville International Education Program **Application Instructions**

NOTE: The application is a PDF format. Make sure you have the most current Acrobat Reader program installed on your computer. All forms need to be typed and submitted in English on the School District of Janesville forms you have been provided. If you are completing forms on-line (internet), please type on indicated lines and print the completed form. Fill out and print one page at a time. If you are not working with an online document, please type information. Your application forms will be submitted by email and by mail as indicated in STEP 13. INCLUDE A COPY OF THIS CHECKLIST WITH APPLICATION. We have offered a place to check each item as it is completed.

STEP 1: Complete page 1 with personal information:

- a) Attach a passport-size photo. This can be a passport, school or digital photo
- b) Include a photo copy of the picture page of your passport. If you do not have a passport, you will need to apply for one as soon as possible.
- c) You are required to submit a recent TOEFL test. Enter your scores on the English Language Learner Program/Placement Recommendation for F-1 Visa Students (page 5 of Application). Please attach a copy of the TOEFL Test Scores Report.

STEP 2: Complete pages 1-2 with personal information and interests:

- a) Please be sure to list all food allergies or preferences.
- b) Please accurately list your language abilities and be detailed about your interests, likes, and dislikes to help us learn more about you.

STEP 3: Complete your Student Letter:

All letters need to be in English and should be typed for electronic distribution. Remember this is your way of letting us know who you are. This letter is to introduce you to your host family and the school. Make the letter as friendly as possible. We want to get to know your personality, so please share your hopes and/or fears, and what you hope to gain from your experience in America. It should be written by you (the student) with no assistance.

STEP 4: Parents must complete a Parent Letter (in English):

All letters need to be in English and should be typed for electronic distribution. Remember this is your way of letting us know more about your child. This letter is to introduce your student to his/her host family and the school. Make the letter as friendly as possible. We want to get to know more about your family and your student, and what you hope your student will gain from his/her experience in America.

STEP 5: Complete Parent / Family Photo Album:

Include as many pages as you would like for your Family Album. Be sure to include pictures of you and your family and some of the activities you participate in. Tell us about the people and places that are in the pictures clearly in English. You can use digital photos or color copies of the originals if they do not take away from the quality of the picture. Or, create a 1-2 minute digital photo slide show and/or video message about you and your family (file format for digital slide show or video should be MP3 or MP4).

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STEP 6: Submit your official TOEFL score:

Please read page 4 of the application regarding English Proficiency and TOEFL requirements. If you have a current TOEFL score report you can submit that with your application. If you need to take the TOEFL test, the links provided will help direct you on how to do that. The *TOEFL*[®] test is offered in two testing formats: the *TOEFL IBT*[®] test, administered via the Internet, and the *TOEFL*[®] PBT test, administered in a paper-based format. The format you take depends on your test center location. When prompted for the school code, please use 7586. When completed, please submit this score report with your application.

STEP 7: Request a written recommendation from your language teacher:

STEP 8: Request an official transcript from your high school:

You may use the transcript provided by your school. An official transcript must have an official school stamp or signature. Please have the teacher/principal translate the grading scale to the US grading scale using the transcript form in the application. Examples are included (pages 8-10), your school can use these if they prefer. Please keep in mind that an overall C average, or 2.0 cumulative GPA, is the minimum requirement for participation in the Janesville International Education Program.

STEP 9: Have your medical doctor complete and sign the Statement of App	licant's Health (pages 11-15)
and an official Immunization record from your home country.	COMPLETE 🛄

This **MUST** be completed by your physician and any chronic ailments should be addressed. If you have had a physical exam within the last six months, your doctor can complete the <u>Statement of Applicant's</u> <u>Health</u> and Immunization Record using the results from your previous physical exam. Additionally, an official immunization record from your home country is required for admission, you MUST have the English translation of the immunizations on the record you provide.

STEP 10: Read through all included documents with your parents, and have them sign and date them. Please be sure the following forms have all been fully completed. Incomplete applications may lead to a delayed or denied acceptance (check off each form to confirm inclusion).

STEP 11: Make arrangements for a wire transfer of the entire tuition and boarding fee for the 1stSemester you will attend in United States Dollars (USD).COMPLETEYou will not submit funds until after you receive your SEVIS I-20 Acceptance from our office and secureyour Visa. Please refer to the Tuition Fees – Refund Policyfor more information. Once your Visa isgranted, we will send you additional forms and instructions for submitting fees. STEP 12: Make two copies of the entire application for your records, give one to your parents and keep one for yourself.

STEP 13: Return of Documents: We recommend scanning and emailing your documents to <u>jiep@janesville.k12.wi.us</u> and we will send you a confirmation of receipt of your application. Please call the office at 001-608-743-5055 to notify us that you have sent your documents by email if you have not received a reply within 2 days. NEXT STEPS beyond the application:

- We will review your application and if you meet the submission requirements and are accepted, our principal will send you a signed SEVIS I-20 document that you will need for your Visa appointment. Please refer to the Requirements for Admission for more information about your Visa documents.
- 2. Once you've received your Visa, additional required forms will be sent to you and your parents by email. These, too, will need to be completed (typed) in English on our forms and returned to the School District of Janesville once your Visa has been granted. Timely return of these documents, along with your payment of tuition are important to securing your admission. Please refer to the <u>Tuition and Fees Refund Policy</u> and the <u>Requirements for Admission</u> pages for more information.
- 3. After the School District of Janesville has confirmed receipt of all required forms and funds, we will prepare for your arrival. More communications and orientations will take place both while you are still in your home country and upon your arrival including necessary placement tests for the school where you will study.

Janesville International Education Program Tuition Costs and Refund Policy

The total tuition cost to attend a Janesville School District High School for the 2015-2016 school year (two semesters), including tuition fees and room & board, is \$24,000 U.S. Dollars. This cost covers all books, materials, lab fees, participation fees, class dues, equipment rentals, plus room and boarding fees for the term of the student visitor's stay. Boarding covers meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) seven days a week and meal expenses for scheduled cultural field trips. Excluded from the tuition, room and board fees are sports physicals (required if student will participate in school sponsored athletics) extended field trips, required health insurance, personal spending money for entertainment, voluntary excursions, vacations, or other matters not provided by the School District of Janesville or the host family.

There are no application fees. Accepted students will be notified and receive the required USCIS I-20 document needed to secure their Visa. Within 3 days of our office receiving notice of your student's acquired Visa, the first semester tuition is due in full (\$12,000 USD) and is required for admission to the School District of Janesville. The tuition payment must be made in the form of an Electronic Fund Wire Transfer. The Electronic Wire Transfer information and instructions will be sent upon the School District of Janesville receipt of student's granted Visa.

The second semester tuition is due by December 15, 2015 through the same Electronic Fund Wire Transfer procedure. If tuition is not received by December 15, 2015, the student will no longer be enrolled in the School District of Janesville and arrangements will be made to send the student home at the expense of the parents.
