

## ■ The Award

Parks Heritage Federal Credit Union awards 4 scholarships annually in the amount of \$250, to be paid jointly to the student and educational institution.

### **■** Eligibility

The applicant and/or the applicant's parents must be a member in good standing of Parks Heritage Federal Credit Union who meets all of the following criteria:

• The member or members child is a college-bound high school senior at the time of application.

Official high school transcript documenting student's GPA for grades 9-11;

- The member or members child is attending college for the first time
- The member or members child will be enrolled in either a two- or four-year accredited educational institution.
- The member or members child agrees to use any scholarship funds awarded within 6 months, at an accredited educational institution only.
