## Data Layout for SAT® and SAT Subject Tests™ Electronic Score Reports

### Introduction

Score reports provide score information that each student selects to send from up to six administrations of the SAT® and six administrations of the SAT Subject Tests™. The reports also include descriptive information if the student completed the SAT Questionnaire, and information about the student's high school.

#### **Important Format Change**

**Beginning in the 2011-12 school year, we will report all score dates using a month-day-year format (MMDDYYYY) instead of simply month-year (MMYY).** We have implemented these changes to modernize the format of SAT score date fields to move to industry standard date reporting. The updates also support the expansion of the testing calendar for the School-Day SAT experience. (See page 2 for more information about School-Day SAT.)

Four positions will be added to each test date, for a total of 48 additional positions overall. All other date fields will remain in their current format. We have noted these changes in this data layout, and for your convenience, we have also provided an SAT Data Layout Crosswalk that shows the prior positions and the new positions of all affected fields. ## **School-Day SAT - Improved Access to the Test**

In 2010, the College Board began an exciting new initiative in which selected districts and states paid for eligible students to take the SAT during a school day at their own high schools. The School-Day SAT will be offered for students in the United States in both the fall and spring of 2011-12, boosting the number of domestic administrations from the current seven to nine.

### **What School-Day SAT Means for Students and High Schools**

School-Day SAT removes barriers for students. Testing on a school day in familiar surroundings means students don't have to juggle competing work or family obligations. Because they are testing in their own school, they don't have to worry about transportation or trying to locate the testing site. They can share the experience with their peers, and they are more likely to know and trust the staff who are administering the test. When a district or state pays for juniors or seniors to take the SAT in their home schools, it sends a powerful message of commitment to preparing all students for the next step. School-Day SAT fosters a culture in which staff, parents and students alike focus more on improving college and workforce readiness.

### **Test Scores**

SAT critical reading, mathematics, and writing section scores and SAT Subject Test scores are reported as three digits on a scale of 200 to 800.

### **Test Dates/Educational Level**

We report test dates by month, day and year, using 01 for January through 12 for December, followed by the two digits of the day and four digits of the year. Every set of scores reported includes the test date and educational level of the student.

### **College Code (positions 1-6)**

Check that the correct four-digit code has been listed for your institution. If you find an error, your data can be recreated if your request is received within 90 days of the report date.

## **Social Security Number (positions 42–50)**

Only complete nine-digit numbers appear in this field. Incomplete numbers are deleted. Students are not required to provide this information.

## **Revised Score (positions 150 and 294)**

Blank = Not revised score, Z = Revised score.

## **SAT Questionnaire Data (positions 711–999)**

We report data from the SAT Questionnaire cumulatively for each student. The latest date for which SAT Questionnaire information was submitted is indicated in positions 711–714. Unanswered SAT Questionnaire questions are left blank.

## **Date of Report (positions 1163–1168)**

This field indicates the date a student's record was created. It can be used to determine the most recent data when multiple records are created for the same student. Positions 1169–1174 are truncated for Internet score delivery recipients.

## **Multiple Records**

Multiple records are created when a student submits more than one request to send a report to your institution within the same reporting period, or if a student takes the SAT and/or SAT Subject Tests™ more than once and does not provide consistent identifying information.

## **Reminders**

The codes for SAT Subject Tests in Mathematics Level 1 and Level 2 changed from 1C and 2C to M1 and M2 in October 2005. The content of the tests has not changed. As of October 2003, the nonstandard administration indicator no longer appears on candidate score reports. As of October 2001, the recentered "R" indicator no longer appears on candidate records.
