	The office of the school nurse was closed when I returned later during the inspection, so I was not able to determine if first aid procedures for accidental poisoning are posted or if the poison control number is also posted. I was also not able to determine if one or more staff members have current first aid certification and if a list of all certified staff is maintained.
