## **RE: PROPOSAL FOR RECYCLING BIKE TIRES AND TUBES**

Tire Stewardship Manitoba (TSM) is the industry association responsible for operating Manitoba's tire recycling program. TSM is proposing a new, voluntary (i.e. non-regulated), recycling initiative for interested bicycle shops across Manitoba. The program will use the existing scrap tire collection infrastructure managed by TSM. Used bicycle tires and tubes have been incorporated into rubber recycling streams in Manitoba on a limited basis for a number of years and there will continue to be no eco-fee or disposal fee charged to the seller or consumer under an expanded or new permanent program.

This program requires the assistance of industry (auto and bicycle), various non-profits and the general cycling community. The long-term success of this recycling program is dependent on the voluntary actions involving the public, bike tire retailers and the many stakeholders already involved in tire recycling.
