





What is a "modern" quilt?

Like past decorative art movements such as the Art Deco style that emerged in the early 1900's or the 1950's Mid Century Modern style that brought us sculpted fiberglass furniture, the modern quilt movement is a fresh approach to quilt making. Look for these style elements:

- Make primarily functional quilts but place a large emphasis on the design and art of quilt making
- Use asymmetry in quilt design
- Rely less on repetition and on the interaction of quilt block motifs
- May contain reinterpreted traditional blocks
- Embrace simplicity and minimalism
- Utilize alternative block structures or lack of visible block structure

- Incorporate increased use of negative space
- Are inspired by modern art and architecture
- Frequently use improvisational piecing
- Contain bold colors, on trend color combinations and graphic prints
- Often use gray and white as neutrals
- Reflect an increased use of solid fabrics
- Focus on finishing quilts on home sewing machines

Jan. 17 OR Feb. 15 10am- 2pm




JUDY NIEMEYER STYLE PAPER PIECING

Two-Day Workshop with Bertie Herman

Saturday, April 14 10am-4pm AND Sunday, April 15 1-4pm

Internationally renown designer Judy Neimeyer's techniques let you create complex, interlocking designs with ease. Our teacher Bertie Herman has studied under Judy and brings her passion to us here in northeast PA. Take your understanding of foundation paper piecing sky high with the *Desert Sky* pattern. Bertie chose Desert Sky for this introduction to Judy Niemeyer style paper piecing because it has all the basic elements--pointy spikes, curves, interlocking shapes, and positive/negative blocks--that allow you to create a gorgeous, breath-taking quilt with ease for your first attempt.

- On Day 1 you will fine tune and organize your fabric choices, pre cut all your shapes, and dive right into the Judy Niemeyer method with the star points. Wrap up with your first curved paper piecing exercises.
- Day 2 brings more practice with curves and joining the units so you can complete the workshop with enough confidence to go home and finish your Desert Sky on your own. Desert Sky is 48" by 54" but can be made larger with extra foundation papers available at the shop.
- Tuition for the 2-day workshop is \$50 plus the pattern and supplies for the project. Call 570-836-7575 to enroll today! Class size is limited.
