

Train the Trainer in Therapeutic Parenting for Professionals Working with Families

This workshop is for those who work with families interested in setting up and running Therapeutic Parenting Courses, or using the concepts in their 1:1 work with families.

Therapeutic Parenting is a program developed for carers and parents of children whose early life may have included neglect, abuse and trauma. Some of these children have challenging behaviours and parents may need more than the usual common sense parenting to develop healthy relationships with their children.

The Therapeutic Parenting course is based on a principle that parenting children who have difficult backgrounds requires some different skills and knowledge to that of parenting children with safe and secure backgrounds. The course enables parents and caregivers to explore messages and reasons behind behaviours and reactions children can have, and consider ways of responding to these in a supportive and effective manner.

The Work Force Development Program is offering the Therapeutic Parenting Train the Trainer to enable you to run Therapeutic Parenting classes with your client groups. You will be provided with the session plans and PowerPoint presentations required to run your own course, as well as readings to support your understanding and for providing to your course participants.

Please note: this training assumes prior experience of running groups, although this is not a requirement for attending.
