# STUDENT SCREENING FOR CREDIT-BY-EXAM

2015-2016 School Year

Students in grades K-5 will have four opportunities during the school year to use “credit-by-exam” to accelerate to another grade level. Students will only have one opportunity to test for each grade level considered.

To apply to take the test to skip kindergarten, a student must be 5 by September 1, and registered in a CFISD school. To apply to take the test to skip grade 1, a student must be 6 by September 1, and enrolled in a CFISD school.

Students who earn scores of 80% or better on each component of the credit-by-exam will qualify to advance one grade. Only one grade level may be “skipped” each year. No retests will be given.

If you are interested in getting more information about credit-by-exam, please contact the school counselor.

Los estudiantes de Kindergarten a 5<sup>to</sup> grado tendrán cuatro oportunidades durante el año escolar para usar el sistema de “crédito por examen” para adelantarse y pasar al siguiente grado. Los estudiantes solo tendrán una oportunidad de rendir la prueba por cada grado considerado.

Para rendir la prueba y saltarse Kindergarten, el estudiante debe cumplir 5 años al 1<sup>ro</sup> de septiembre y estar inscrito en una escuela de CFISD. Para rendir la prueba y saltarse 1<sup>er</sup> grado, el estudiante debe cumplir 6 años al 1<sup>ro</sup> de septiembre y estar inscrito en una escuela de CFISD.

Los estudiantes que obtengan puntajes de 80% o más en cada uno de los componentes de las evaluaciones de “crédito por examen” calificarán para ser avanzados un grado. Solo se puede saltar un grado por año. No se pueden repetir las pruebas.

## LAST DAY OF SCHOOL PARTY PRE-REGISTRATION

Parties are intended for students and parents/grandparents are invited to join us as guests. Any guests are required to wear VSoft stickers when they visit Keith Elementary. VSoft nametags can be printed from a valid driver's license from any state, a military I.D., or state I.D.

**Please note that any school-age students/siblings may not attend holiday parties.**

For the safety of our students and in order to accommodate the large number of visitors that attend Last Day of School parties at Keith, we are requesting that everyone pre-register. Visitors who have not pre-registered will need to wait in very long, time-consuming lines due to the Vsoft system. **No exceptions will be made.**

If you have previously visited Keith and had your license scanned, you may fill out the form below and return it to the school by **May 29**. We will be able to print you a Vsoft sticker before you arrive; therefore, there will be no need to check in at the office on the day of the party. If you (or someone you are pre-registering) have not had a driver's license scanned at a previous event, you may stop in any time during normal school hours before **May 29<sup>th</sup>** and have your driver's license scanned to save time waiting in line the day of the event.

**If you do not pre-register and ensure that your license has been scanned, you will be required to have your license scanned on party day. The system is often slow, and the line may take a while.** All visitors should be prepared to present a photo ID even if they have pre-registered.

**Please note:** Parents who have pre-registered and will be checking their child out after the party may sign their child out with the homeroom teacher.

Guests, other than parents, who intend on checking the child out, must report to the front office for sign out. If a guest will be signing out your child, a parent/guardian must provide a written note to Keith Elementary **prior to 9:30 a.m.** on the party day. **No exceptions will be made.**

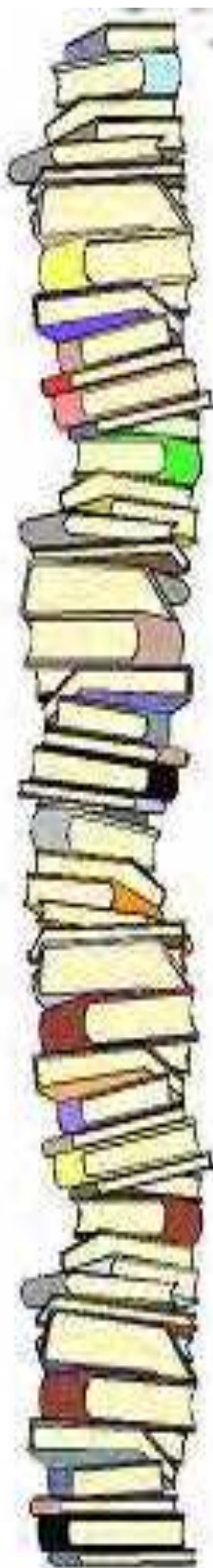

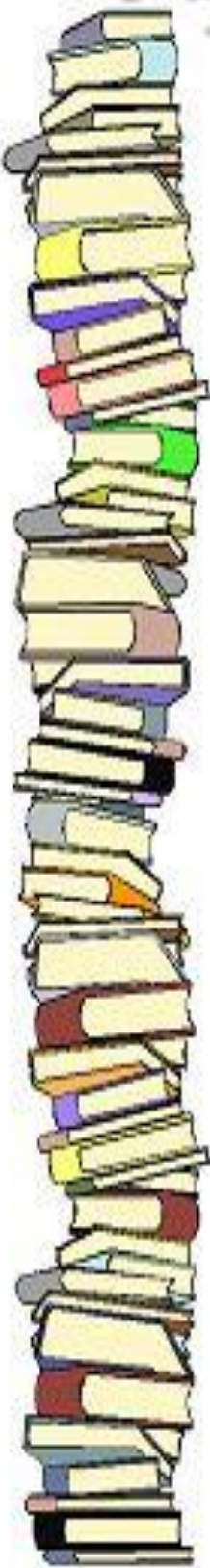
