Globalization has made a dramatic impact on all aspects of life in cities and nations on every continent. Challenges raised by immediate and personal experiences of significant cultural, ethnic and religious differences make it imperative to clarify the principles and values that can form the basis of social cohesion. One Family Under God anchors a new interfaith paradigm that speaks to the essence of our common identity – that all people are spiritual beings who share a common origin. This approach has significant implications for addressing the roots of identity-based conflict as well as tapping the creative energy and drive of vibrant interfaith partnerships.

"Universal Principles at the Basis of National Cohesion"

Most nations today are comprised of populations that are radically, ethnically, and religiously diverse. What can be the basis for forging societal cohesion and national identity in a pluralistic society? This session will examine the focus on **essential principles** as the basis for "unity in diversity". Two cases studies will be considered – USA with its focus on "self-evident truths" and its motto of "epluribus unum" (out of many, one); and Indonesia, which has pursued a national motto of "unity in diversity" while basing its national philosophy on Pancasila, five principles intended to serve as the basis of cohesion in a diverse nation.



VISA

Visiting Indonesia without Any Visa

Entering Indonesia without any visa is possible now only for nationals of the following 11 countries and territories: Brunei Darussalam, Chile, Hong Kong, Macau, Malaysia, Morocco, Peru, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.

Citizens of the above countries will be issued on arrival a stay permit for 30 days free of charge upon presentation of a passport which is valid at least for another 6 months.

VISA on ARRIVAL (VoA)

Citizens of the following countries will be able to apply for a VoA valid for 30 days upon arrival by air at Jakarta International Airport. A 30-day visa costs US\$25.

Algeria, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Bahrain, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, Estonia, Fiji, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Holland, Hungary, Iceland, India, Iran, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Kuwait, Laos, Latvia, Libya, Lichtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Maldives, Malta, Mexico, Monaco, New Zealand, Norway, Oman, Panama, People's Republic of China, Poland, Portugal, Qatar, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Suriname, Switzerland, Sweden, Taiwan, Tunisia, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom and the United States of America.

Travelers from the above countries must be in possession of a passport which is <u>valid for at least 6 months</u> from the date of arrival and the completed embarkation/disembarkation card they received from their airline. They must also be able to prove they have sufficient funds for their stay in Indonesia. Arriving travelers with Visa-On-Arrival status have to go first to one of the "VoA Counters" to pay the appropriate fee and have their passports stamped with the VoA before proceeding to the Immigration Clearance Desk.

Requirement and Types of Visa Before Arrival

Citizens of countries neither on the VoA nor Visa-Free lists are <u>required to apply for a visa</u> at an overseas Indonesian Consulate or Foreign Mission before departing for Indonesia.

Upon request, our office will provide you with a letter that you can take to the consulate in your country when you make your visa application. **NOTE:** The full amount of the registration fee must be paid before the GPF AP Secretariat will issue a letter of invitation.

LANGUAGE

The conference will be conducted in English.

INSURANCE AND LIABILITY FOR LOSS

Participants are responsible to arrange their own travel insurance. The GPF AP Secretariat (and all other sponsoring or hosting organization) is not responsible for loss of private property (such as lost luggage) or for personal medical conditions. Please consult your health insurance carrier about international travel and prepare all the necessary documents that would be needed in the event of an emergency. This should include but not be limited to the exact contact information for your doctors, prescription details, etc.

PROGRAM SESSION PROTOCOL

In the spirit of collegial exchange, all participants agree to respect the scheduled program speakers' right to speak uninterrupted. Conference participants may use designated question and answer periods for questions and comments.

- 8. You agree that if there is any dispute concerning your participation in the program or the interpretations of this Agreement, any such disagreement shall be determined in accordance with the laws of Indonesia.

- 9. The terms and conditions of this Waiver and Release of Liability represent your complete understanding of the subject matter hereof, and supersede any previous or contemporaneous understandings you may have had with the GPF AP on this subject, whether written or oral, and cannot be changed or amended in any way without the written concurrence of both the GPF AP Secretariat and yourself.
- 10. You agree that should any provision or aspect of this Agreement be found to be unenforceable, that all remaining provisions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect.
- 11.YOU HAVE CAREFULLY READ THE ABOVE CONFERENCE POLICIES, RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THIS DOCUMENT'S CONTENTS.
