Heiwa, Nissui Scholarship Information

1. Heiwa Nakajima Foundation Scholarship -2012

Qualifications (*):

(1) Self-supporting international students who are enrolled in universities in Japan at the time of application, and are/will be enrolled in the regular course in the 2012 academic year.

(2) With “college student” resident status.

(3) Not receiving other scholarships/grants (However, those receiving less than 30,000 Yen per month are eligible to apply.)

*Those extending the regular academic period are not eligible to apply.

*Past recipients of scholarships from the Heiwa Nakajima Foundation are not eligible to apply.

Number: One (for undergraduate students), One (for graduate students) –Based upon the course enrolled as of April 2012

Scholarship amount per month:

100,000 Yen for undergraduate/graduate students

Scholarship grant period: April 2012 ~ March 2013 (One year)

Deadline: Apply until September 26, 2011 (Mon) to the International Student Section. Applicants must abide by the deadline and submit application on time.

To apply, submit Form 3 (Application Form for Scholarships by Private Foundation) directly to the International Student Section, or send it by e-mail attachment to ryugaku@ofc.a.u-tokyo.ac.jp or fax to 03-5841-8168 (Ext.28168)

International Student Section will send a confirmation e-mail to the applicants who applied through e-mail or fax.

2. Nissui Research Fund -2012

Qualifications:

- (1) Self-supporting international students enrolled in the regular course of doctoral course and doing research on fisheries (aqua farming, processing, and others).
- (2) Not receiving the same kind of grant from other foundations.
- (3) Able to submit a report to Nippon Suisan Kaisha, Ltd., after the grant duration.
- (4) Able to participate in the debrief meeting and report research achievement.

Grant amount: 300,000 ~ 500,000 Yen

Grant period: January 2012 ~ December 2012 (one year)

Deadline: Apply by e-mail not later than October 31, 2011 (Mon) to Nissui Research Fund. Applicants are expected to abide by the deadline and submit application on time.
