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NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES AND ADVERTISING

- 1.1 The races will be governed by rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* including Appendix D.
- 1.2 USCG approved personal floatation devices (PFDs) shall be available to competitors at all times while on the water by competitors. All competitors must supply their own PFDs, which shall be worn outside of all clothing when worn.
- 1.3 Advertising will be restricted to ISAF Category A.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Eligible competitors for PHRF racing shall be mono-hull boats belonging to or chartered to members of the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club, and skippered by members of the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club or their family. If a boat does not have a PHRF number, one may be assigned by the Principal Race Officer for the regatta at the Captain's Meeting. The Race Committee encourages all yachts to obtain a PHRF certificate through the YRALIS. The race will be held in a "Pursuit" format where all boats will receive a starting time that will be for their boat and any other boat with the same PHRF. The theory is that everyone should finish at once.
- 2.2 Eligible competitors for one design racing shall be one design boats belonging to or chartered to members of the Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club and skippered by a member or their family.
- 2.3 Skippers should complete the "Annual Club Rendezvous Entry Form" by July 11, 2014 at 1400.
