Please read and initial:

- _____ **Discipline (Required):** If a child is disrespectful or rude, he/she will return to his or her parent(s) or guardian for the remainder of the service. Examples include: Inappropriate comments, unkindness, and not cooperating with the group's guides. Please talk with your child(ren) and initial your understanding and cooperation with this policy.
- _____ **Parent/Guardian Present at Service (Required):** A parent or designated guardian must be present on campus during the class time. This is NOT a drop and pick up program.
- _____ **Sick Child (Required):** If your child is ill, please do not bring them to class. There should be no fever, diarrhea or vomiting 24 hours prior to class. This will help all of our families to stay healthy.
