The 2015 IHSBCA State Clinic saw an attendance of over 500 coaches on hand to listen to presenters, discuss baseball ideas, and visit the displays presented by exhibitors and college programs from throughout the state.

The annual Hall of Fame banquet on Friday evening was well attended as the Hall of Fame welcomed five new inductees.

This years inductees included five coaches who have combined for over 2.700 wins. 45 sectional titles, 14 regional crowns, a couple sate titles and each has played an active role in the IHSBCA throughout his coaching career.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR UPDATE

If you had the opportunity to attend the state clinic this year then consider yourself to be a part of the largest clinic in recent memory (maybe ever!). 503 coaches were in attendance in Indianapolis; along with a record number of vendors, excellent speakers, and numerous college coaches. One of the highlights of the weekend was the Hall of Fame banquet where 325 people packed the main ballroom to honor our 5 newest inductees (Jim Reid, Al Rabe, Bob Shinkan, Phil Webster, and Chip O'Neil). It was an amazing weekend!

Several new ideas were on display in Indianapolis this year with our on-site district meetings (these replaced our fall meetings) that were well attended and a raffle sponsored by Zephyr Hats. Zephyr donated a set of 72 hats that can be customized and this year's inaugural winner was Brad Lightfoot of MDS Bats.

While I know I will miss someone. I have to take a moment and thank the people who coordinate

the different aspects of our clinic and without them it could not run as smoothly as it does. Scott Hughes (clinic chair and his committee); Gary O'Neal(HOF Banquet); Ryan Bunnell (handles the speakers); Jeff McKeon (vendor chairman); Ken Seitz (registration); Shawn Lyons (college coaches); and the Executive Council. Moving forward let's start talking about the spring season. The pre-season poll will be out March 9 so if your team deserves some recognition contact your district rep. or your poll panel member immediately. Practice begins March 16 and games will be here before you know it. It will be a welcome relief from the snow and cold I have seen so far this winter.

All-State voting will be done online this year. More details will follow in the May newsletter, but we are currently working with a vendor who does this for other associations and finalizing the agreement. The nominations and voting will all occur through a link from the IHSBCA website and I am hopeful this will dramatically increase the number of votes received.

This is also our year to submit proposals to the IHSAA so if you have something to be considered please contact me by March 15. The timing of this process is very important.

Finally, I know through my updates in the past I have challenged you to make a difference in the lives of our young people. As coaches we spend a lot of time with open gyms, conditioning, skill development, and other physical activities. How much time do you spend with developing their character?

Some coaches will say "I am not qualified or prepared to have those discussions with my players" and I can understand the apprehension of trying to break through 'the crust' of a 17 or 18-year-old male. It is not easy; however, every time you are around them you are sharing your personal character with them by your words and actions...you are an example simply by the position you hold as a coach. You never know what will impact them down the road so be intentional every day in the message you are sending. Go out each day and make a difference!

PLAYER SPOTLIGHT— ADAM LIND

Adam Lind was acquired by the Milwaukee Brewers this offseason bringing him to the NL after spending parts of nine seasons with the Blue Jays who drafted him in the 3rd round in 2004. Adam is a 2002 graduate of Anderson Highland where he was All-State and a North All-Star selection as a senior. Originally drafted in 2002 by the Twins, Adam instead went to the University of

South Alabama for two years where he was a 2nd team Freshman All-American and then a Sun Belt All-Star Outfielder his sophomore season. Lind made his MLB debut in September of 2006. In 9 seasons, Adam has hit 146 HR's, collected 519 RBI's and has a career average of .273. His best season was 2013 when he hit .288 with 23 HR's and 67 RBI's. Following a broken foot last season that put him on the disabled list, Adam came back to hit .321 with 40 RBI's in 96 games.
