Dear Families,

Welcome back to school. What a summer we had at One Planet! It was full of adventures-swimming lessons at UVAC, creating and using simple machines, putting on theater performances, learning survival skills, gardening, service learning, cookouts and much, much more! Fun with One Planet will continue this fall as we welcome new and veteran staff and Program Leaders.

INCREASE IN FEES: One Planet has worked very hard to sustain our program through a variety of funding sources so that we can offer the program at an affordable price to our families. Because of this, we have been able to keep our daily fees at a very reasonable \$7 (or \$3) a day for the past 6 years. This year, we are making a small increase in fees to \$8/day (or \$4/day for f/r lunch students) to help offset inflation and growing staff expenses. We hope this will not deter your family from continuing to use our program. Thank you for your support as we continue to serve you and your children with affordable, high quality programming.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: **We want ALL families who are interested in One Planet to be able to use this valuable resource.** Please know that if the daily fee is too expensive, there are options available. As a first option, families would apply for Child Care Financial Assistance through the Vermont Department of Children and Families. Should a family be denied assistance, partial and full scholarships are available through One Planet. In order to be considered for a One Planet scholarship, a letter of denial is required from DCF. Please see page 3 for more details.

EXPANSION: We are happy to announce that One Planet has expanded to include Chelsea and Newton this year. We are glad to be able to offer this service to students across the entire SU.

SESSION I Special Program Schedule - Sharon

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS

Open Art: Open Art will allow various program leaders to share their talents with the kids, and offer a variety of art, cooking and woodworking. The kids will work with wood and real tools, and other art forms as their interests mandate. As the weather turns colder, we'll switch from woodworking to multicultural cooking as an optional activity for the last 6-7 weeks of Session I. Students will have an opportunity to make authentic choices throughout the 13 week session. Taught by Amber Tatro, and other OP staff.

Swords & Stick Play: We will start with choosing characters and costumes, create a scenario involving a sword ritual. We will cut and strip saplings to create our swords. After the sword ritual, the students will choose what they wish to explore through Creative Play. This could be theater-based, arts, building something, or whatever they dream up and would like to try. The kids will be guided through group work while they make authentic choices during creative playtime. Taught be Carol Langstaff, founder of Revels North.

Caretakers of our Earth - We will explore some of the ways kids of all ages can help take care of our earth, including: taking care of plants, how to keep the air, water, and soil clean and free from pollution, respect the lives of animals and humans, use only we need and use resources wisely, pick up trash and reuse and recycle. We will talk about how the best thing we can do for our planet starts with us being the best human being we can be by taking care of ourselves. Each lesson will then be represented with either a creative project (making bird feeders out of a reused milk jugs, planting seeds in egg cartons and caring for the seedling, making art out of recyclables, making dog and cat toys for a local animal shelter, etc.), a creative writing project (poems, stories, illustrations) and/or a skit acting out situations in which the kids are good earth stewards. Taught by educator with PhD in Sustainable Energy.

High-Five Sports: The sports program would consist of learning the basic rules and fundamentals of several different team sports, including soccer and basketball. We would focus on teamwork and sportsmanship. Skills and drills will be a major focus as well. The end goal will be for students to gain enough knowledge and skill to play a game while implementing teamwork and positive sportsmanship. Taught by OP staff member Donna Locke, a long-time coach.

The Young Entrepreneur: The younger students will focus on harvesting vegetables and herbs, preparing ingredients and experimenting with pizza making and dough. Older students will cook the pizzas using our new pizza oven, as well as learn the business side of things, including basic book-keeping, inventory, measuring profit/loss, sourcing materials and keeping a ledger. Lead by licensed educator Paul Sadowski, in prep and partnership with Cindy Perry.

One Planet Fee Policy and Procedure

1. Program Fees

The One Planet Program is funded by several funding sources, including a 21st Century Learning Center Grant, additional state grants, fees, school and town funds, and state subsidies. (We are a licensed childcare facility.) We project that over 25% of our total annual budget will be covered by fees and subsidies. Fees and subsidy income is vital to the future of this program. Fees are adjusted based on the number of children within a family attending and the family's free/reduced lunch status. See *Fee Table* below:

2. Payment

One Planet wants its programs to be available to the maximum number of students. Enrollment for One Planet Programs is limited and student commitment to participation is important.

All students will receive a program registration packet 3x/year. The parent is then responsible for completing the fee worksheet and returning the enrollment form, fee worksheet and at least 50% of total fee due, 3x/year. The other 50% will be due at mid-session. *Please note: Credits are not issued for non-attendance.* Failure to return either the quarterly enrollment form/fee worksheet, or make a payment, will prevent the student from continuing in the program.

If 50% of payment is not received in advance of the session, and other arrangements have not been made with the One Planet Site Coordinator, the student will be considered withdrawn from the program until payment is made.

3. Alternative Fee Arrangements

One Planet does not limit enrollment based on a family's ability to pay. Other options are available if needed:

a) Child Care Financial Assistance Program (formerly known as Child Care Subsidy)

The One Planet Program is eligible for childcare assistance through the VT Department of Children and Families. Qualifying families can receive assistance from 10% to 100% of One Planet daily fees depending on their incomes. Parents must have a service need, i.e. be working, going to school or receiving training, seeking employment or have circumstances that require outside assistance. We strongly encourage interested families in applying for CCFAP, as this payment from the state helps sustain our program. The One Planet Program may have forms and brochures on hand. b) Scholarships

Scholarships are available to families who qualify for free/reduced lunch, but who are not eligible for CCFAP. We ask families to pay what they can afford and we will do our best to cover the remaining amount.

Families are responsible for payment that is not reimbursed by CCFAP or covered by a scholarship. Failure to pay or make other arrangements will place your child in withdraw status. Filing for financial assistance promptly will help minimize your costs.
