**JEFF HAEFKE-** 45 passed away Tues. Apr 21 2015. Jeff raced Stocks and then Emods all over the area competing against his brother Steve. Jeff's 2 sons Jeff Jr. and Matt also race Micro sprints in the area. Jeff is the son of Hall of Fame driver Butch Haefke. Besides his father and sons he leaves his mother Jean Kochera; his wife Lorraine Tufaro Haefke; three sisters, Kimberly Haefke Waggett ,Tina (Ron) Epperhart and Jodi Haefke, three brothers, Steve Haefke (fiance Shelley Nastasi) of Youngstown, Bill (Hilary) Calton and Bryan (Kelly) Calton. Memorial contributions maybe made to the Haefke Memorial Fund in care of Farmers National Bank.

**GUS LINDER-** 86 passed away Apr 29 2015.Gus's raced over four decades, and is one of the racing legends in West. Pa. He was inducted into the Western Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame in 1976 alongside Art Rooney Sr., whom he sat next to during the ceremony. He also was honored by the Dapper Dan Hall of Fame, Tri-City Speedway Hall of Fame, Circle Track Hall of Fame, and our Twin State Hall of Fame. He won over 250 races all over the east coast. **BOBBY HAMMOND** 66 passed away on Apr 15 2015. Bobby owned and operated a fabricating shop specializing in drive shafts. He could make and fabricate all needed parts and repairs. He was "king" of drive shafts. Bobby built and drove stock cars at many speedways, including Canfield, Sharon, Butler, Pittsburgh. Orrville, and Expo. He also helped his father Donnie maintain the Canfield Speedway track. Bobby received state champion in 1979 (track rabbit), a go-cart made in Sebring, Ohio. He raced at Lake Placentia, Sebring and Youngstown. He was inducted into the Twin-state Hall of Fame Racing Club as a driver-mechanic.

**RODNEY FRANKLIN-** 61,of White Post, Virginia, passed April 22, 2015. He was a top Late Model Dirt track driver in the 80's and 90's. Winning races in the Northeast, Mid-Atlantic and down South earned him the nickname "The Virginia Leadfoot". In 1979 he became the Winchester Speedway Track Champion, and in 1997 and 1998 the Hagerstown Speedway Track Champion. In 2004 Rodney was inducted into the National Dirt Track Late Model Hall of Fame. **ROD ARTMAN-** 51, of Sandy Creek Township, Hadley, Pa passed away Saturday morning, April 18, 2015. He had been a truck driver for more than 30 years and for the past 10 years, he had been employed at K&J Trucking in Hadley. He was a member of Hartstown Volunteer Fire Department Pump House 45. Rod was an avid Harley Davidson motorcycle rider, hunter and fisherman. He was also extremely active with racing, competing in micro sprint and go-cart racing as a youth, and has had a long career of dirt track racing of modifieds and e-mods at both Sharon and Mercer speedways.
