Dear Coach:

As you should be aware, for the past several years, the Bowling Federation of Alberta has operated a Summer Youth Bowling Camp during the month of August. Perhaps the toughest task myself and the host coordinators take on each year is getting enough qualified and enthusiastic coaches for the bowling youth of this province.

To this end, I would like to issue you this personal invitation to submit your application to coach at this summer's camp. It will be held in Edmonton during the period of August 11th through 14th, with the accommodations being provided at The King's University. As always, this year's camp will provide more than just on-lane instruction by including video analysis, guest speakers, group discussions and presentations, and a wind up tournament and party. All coaches will be requested to provide one-on-one and small group instructions, as well as act as chaperones while the students are in the residence. While you are in Edmonton, all costs of accommodation, meals, and transportation to and from all Camp functions will be covered by the BFA, and a small honorarium will be paid to each coach in order to cover his or her expenses to attend.

Again for this season is the requirement for all Coach Application Forms to be complete with a Certified Police Check. Once supplied to us, this document shall be considered as supplied and valid for the next three years, so if you have sent one in for previous Camps, you need not send it again unless that three-year period has now expired. Applications received without this documentation will not be considered.

It's only with your assistance that we can continue to make our Youth Bowling Camp a helpful and memorable occasion for the young bowlers of Alberta. Please complete the enclosed application form and return it to me as soon as possible. We will attempt to select our Coaches early this spring, allowing all to make holiday arrangements with their employers.
