#### Fairness Doctrine and localism threaten Catholic radio

Catholic radio is facing serious threats posed by reinstituting a federal law called the Fairness Doctrine. This legislation would mandate radio stations air opposing points of view for each issue broadcast. For example, if a station runs a program supporting the view that marriage is between a man and woman, this legislation would require the station to run the opposing view.

While the Fairness Doctrine is making headlines, another proposal called localism is also being discussed without the media hype. This localism concept has the potential to achieve the same end.

While the Fairness Doctrine regulates the range of opinions that should be heard on a radio station,

localism regulates the service provided to the station's local community. But the impact of localism could be the same as the Fairness Doctrine, since the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) can take away a station's license if it's found not to serve the interests of the local community.

For over a year the FCC has been quietly progressing through internal rulemaking proceedings in order to change broadcast rules. Under the title of *Report on Broadcast Localism and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*, localism would impose new regulations that could restrict free speech rights and religious liberty, both of which have the potential to destroy Catholic radio.
