


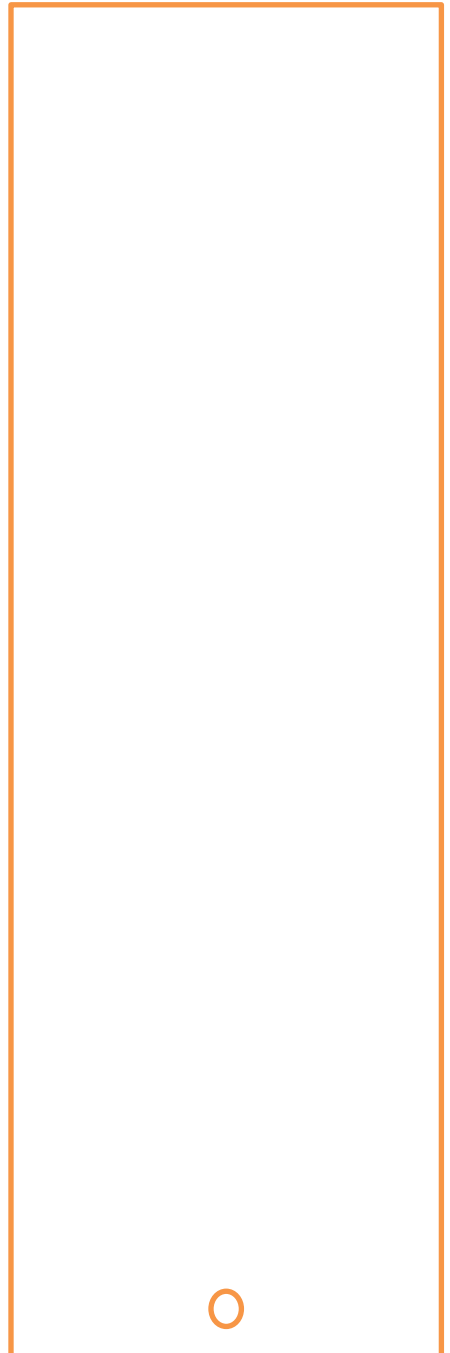
# Youth Literacy 2015 Children & Youth Bookmark Contest for ages 6-18: Ghosts

There will be one **junior winner** (6-12) and one **senior winner** (13-18). Winners will be announced and all entries will be displayed at Victoria Jubilee Hall in Walkerton as part of the Words Aloud family production performance **Ghosts of Grey County** on Sunday, November 1<sup>st</sup> at 2 pm. The winning designs will be produced as a fundraiser for Youth Literacy for 2015-16.

## Contest rules:

The theme for the contest is "Ghosts". Your design should have some connection to ghosts.

Each entry must be the original work of one young person.

Designs may be either horizontal or vertical. Complete the bookmark space provided on this entry form and turn in the entire form intact.

Words and numbers may form part of the design, but your name can't appear anywhere in the design.

Do not use commercial or copyrighted names, characters, logos or designs.

The contest runs from September 21<sup>st</sup> to October 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015.

**All entries must be received at the Youth Literacy office by Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> at 5 pm.**

A winner will be selected by a panel from Youth Literacy volunteers in two age groups: 6-12 and 13-18. Winners will be notified by phone on October 29<sup>th</sup>.

Winners will receive a family pass to the production of Ghosts of Grey County and a prize package, along with a copy of their bookmark.
