Message from the Chairman

Dear Friends,

Earlier this month, I went to Bali to represent our Association at the Urological Association of Asia Council Meeting. Bill, as President of UAA, was of course also there. I could provide him alibi only on one of the evenings when we went out with Dr HO from Macau to have a couple of satays and beers in a background of singing performance. There were checks for bombs under vehicles at many of the sites we visited. We hope that the situation would be less tense when our delegates go there for the 2006 ACU. The venue was tranquil and remote, and would be a nice resort to enjoy some massage, spa and a Pacific sunset. Professor KT FOO, spirit of UAA for many years, announced his wish to step down as Secretary General. While we cherish his immense contributions to the UAA throughout these years, his departure may help to clarify the unhappy misconception by some that Singapore has been dominating over UAA affairs. The new Secretary General, I hope, could cultivate greater sense of belonging from countries outside Southeast Asia as well. Unfortunately, Bill didn't appear to be interested in such job.

I represented the Association in the editorial board for revising guidelines for use of laser in health care spearheaded by the Hong Kong Surgical Laser Association. A little booklet of guidelines was produced ten years ago and Dr WATT Chung Yin, our retired member, had helped to write most of it. Dr WATT would be a difficult example to follow and I would just try my best for the part related to urology. Many lasers had come and gone and only some would likely be there to stay. The green laser was warmly received by our members in the recent workshop organized by Dr SZETO of North District Hospital. We need to maintain an open mind and a close scrutiny to any new technology in our armamentarium.

On 22 July, the Association presented our view to Dr York CHOW, Secretary of Health, Welfare & Food in one of his consultative meetings on the future health care delivery model in Hong Kong. Meanwhile we acknowledge the sincerity and courage Dr CHOW has demonstrated in openly addressing issues of priority in health care delivery, we warned Dr CHOW not to be too categorical. We coined the specific example of patients with retention of urine due to benign prostatic hyperplasia. They are not having a malignant disease and appear stable on catheter. They have no earning power and no insurance cover. They are liable to remain neglected if priority issues are pushed too far. The government should continue with their commitment to this needy group.
