City of Schertz FIXTURE REBATE PROGRAM POLICY

The City of Schertz Public Works and Inspection Department has been authorized by the City Manager and City Council to establish a toilet rebate program. Set forth is the policy regulating the rules and condition of this program. The intent of the program is to encourage conservation of water by replacing toilets that exceed 1.6-gallon capacity.

State Plumbing Codes have required low-flow toilets to be installed in all new construction since 1987. The larger volume toilets were taken off the market at the same time. Any Business or Residence built after 1987 will not qualify for a fixture rebate.

- 1. Basic information for the file will consist of the date of application, applicants name, address, phone number and number of toilet fixtures to be replaced.
- 2. Customer must provide the brand name of new fixture(s) and gallon capacity. All new toilets must be 1.6 gallon capacity or less. The application will be denied if the new fixture is greater than 1.6 gallons. Rebates will not be given if you are replacing an existing 1.6 with a 1.28/1.2 gallon capacity.
- 3. The City Inspector will confirm proper installation and ensure the toilet meets the specifications of 1.6 gallon or less. Each household/business is limited to a maximum of 2 fixtures per calendar year, not to exceed a total of 4 within a 5-year period. The Inspector must be able to verify the gallon capacity of the old fixture. DO NOT discard the old fixture. A rebate will not be approved without the old fixture.
- 4. The owner shall provide a copy of the receipt (proof of purchase) and must be attached to the application.
- 5. It shall be the owner's responsibility to make arrangements for inspection of the new toilet and old toilet, with the city Inspector.
- 6. No filing fees will be due for filing of the application under this program and there will be no fee for the pick-up of the old fixture.
- 7. After the inspection has been completed by the City Inspector. The Public Works will assign a pick up day for the removal of the old fixture.
- 8. The Application will then be sent to the City Finance Department for processing a rebate check in the amount of fifty dollars (\$ 50.00) per toilet. A copy of the application will be retained with the Public Works Department for a minimum of five years for reference.
