Awana Clubs will be running from 6:30 PM until 8:15 PM at Osceola Grace Brethren Church, located at 58343 Apple Rd, Osceola, IN 46561. Although our clubs begin on September 7th, we will be accepting new registration forms every Wednesday at club meetings. We will also have two buses providing free transportation to and from our club. If your child needs bus transportation and they did not attend last year, please contact our office to see if there is transportation in your area.

Regarding fees, the program is free, however, there is a suggested donation of \$15.00 per clubber for the 2011-2012 year. These donations help defray the cost of awards, teaching materials, Awana Store items, and special events. Your donation can be paid in full or can be paid in several increments. Example: \$.50 each night or three payments of \$5.00. If this creates a financial burden for your family please let an administrator in our Awana Office know, as no child will be excluded from our program due to the inability to make a donation. As your clubber progresses through their free initial handbook, they will be able to purchase additional Awana handbooks and a uniform/t-shirt for an additional fee. Although the purchase of these items is highly encouraged, it is not a requirement to participate.

AWANA Clubs

Our AWANA club is made up of separate groups:

- Cubbies — Ages 3 (by Sept. 1) and 4 preschoolers
- Sparks — Kindergarten through 2nd grades
- Truth and Training (T&T) - 3rd through 6th grades

The clubs are held on **Wednesday evenings from 6:30-8:15 PM during the school year (September to May)**. Special Theme Nights are arranged to create excitement and anticipation by the clubbers. It is not required that clubbers dress up or participate in every theme night. A year of tentative themes for each night is provided at the beginning of the Awana Club Year to help in preparation for the themes.

We are committed to running a program where children learn to know, love, and serve God. While we believe this is a serious mission, we also believe in having fun in the process. Our Awana club is also a way for us to positively impact our local community, families, and schools.

It is our desire that all interested children know about Awana and have an opportunity to participate. We would like to assist children who might have transportation needs; though we cannot meet all transportation needs in all areas. Please inform us of children who might have transportation challenges during the enrollment process.

Please feel free to visit our club meetings anytime. There are a few special events that are designed to involve the whole family and we encourage you to participate with us.
